

## **VOLLEYBALL (AA Girls)**

1. AA Girls Volleyball is played in four zones: South, Central, North, and West.
2. Okanagan Championship host will rotate among the four zones:  
2024 Central  
2025 West  
2026 North  
2027 South
3. There will be a maximum of 8 berths for the Okanagan Championships for the AA tier.
4. A zone playoff will determine the teams representing each zone at the Valley Championships.
5. Two berths will be allocated to each zone; however, a zone having two or less teams shall receive only one berth with the extra berth going to one of the larger zones. Number two in the smaller zone shall have the right to challenge #3 from the larger zone for the berth.
6. If a zone has only one school registered in the league their berth will go to the zone that they join for league play.
7. Singleton teams must declare at the start of the season which zone they plan to join for playoff purposes.
8. A zone with no teams registered shall surrender their berth to the largest zone.
9. Extra berth allotment would be determined each year by the commissioner.

10. In Valley Championships there is rally point to 15 in the final game (and no cap).

The commissioner will collect rankings from each team the week prior to the Okanagan Championship. The pool formation will be determined based on the rankings of all the AA teams who have qualified for the Okanagan Championship:

Pool A

#1,3,5,8

Pool B

#2,4,6,7

After round robin play, the first place teams receive a bye.

The Saturday game format is as follows: 4TH VS 4TH GAME (1) (for 7th and 8th place) – best 2 of 3

QUARTER FINALS (2) A2 vs. B3 (3) B2 vs. A3 – best 2 of 3

SEMI FINALS (4) A1 vs. winner 3 (5) B1 vs. winner 2 – best 2 of 3

CONSOLATION (6) Loser 4 vs. Loser 5 – best 3 of 5

FINALS (7) Winner 4 vs. Winner 5 – best 3 of 5

Rules & Regulations: Volleyball In cases where the winner of (6) has not lost to loser (7) and there are only two berths to the Provincials for the Okanagan there will be a backdoor challenge hosted by the loser of (7).
