NEW REGISTRATION INFORMATION PACKET





Welcome New Scouts and Families to Pack 67! We are excited to have you join us. It is our hope that your Scout will have fun adventures and great learning experiences through Scouting. This registration packet provides guidance to new Scouts and Families on how to get started in Scouting. If you have any questions at any time please don't hesitate to ask. We are here to help you!

Here are some things that you need to know:

- All Scouts must complete a Boy Scouts of America Youth Application and an Annual Health and Medical Record form. The Youth Application is used to record your Scout's participation in Cub Scouts. The Health and Medical Record form provides the Pack with the best understanding of your Scout's physical capabilities and is needed for outdoor excursions. Scouts and participating Family must complete a new Health and Medical Record form each year.
- Our Pack Committee Members and Adult Leaders are all volunteers for BSA. The Pack is actively recruiting throughout the year for adult volunteers to help our Scouts and provide a quality program for the Pack. **If you are interested in being anAdult Volunteer** or want more information, please contact our Committee Chair, Cubmaster, or any otherAdult Leader.
- The **Pack membership fee** is used to register new Scouts or re-charter current Scouts. It also *includes the Pack's insurance fee, Pack Dues to pay for program supplies, and a 12 month subscription to Boy's Life Magazine!* This membership fee is paid once every calendar year and covers from January through December. Our Pack does offer a payment plan for families with financial challenges, if you are interested please contact our Pack Treasurer for more information. For questions regarding registration, please contact our Pack Membership Coordinator.
- **Scout Uniforms:** Each Scout should wear the official Boy Scouts of America Cub Scout Uniform at Pack and Den activities unless otherwise specified. The **Scout Field Uniform** consists of the blue Cub Scout shirt with patches, Cub Scout belt, and rank specific neckerchief and slide. Rank specific hats are encouraged, but optional. The **Pack Activity Uniform** is an optional t-shirt with Pack logo that families can purchase separately. This shirt is usually worn during outdoor or messy activities to protect the Field Uniform from damage.
- HELPFUL TIP: Consider purchasing a larger size uniform that your Scout can grow into over the course of their time in Cub Scouts. Additionally, 4th and 5th graders in Webelos have the option of purchasing the tan Scouts BSAuniform shirt in preparation of their transition to the next program.
- Our **Scouts typically meet on Mondays from 6:30 7:30 pm at Baylake United Methodist Church**. The first three weeks of the month are usually reserved for Den Meetings, while the last Monday is usually a Pack meeting. *Any changes due to holidays, weather, or ongoing events will be sent out via our Facebook page, the Pack newsletter, and email from Pack and Den Leaders.*

Den Meetings: Scouts and Families that actively participate in the Dens experience Scouting at its best! In the dens, Scouts get to build friendships and learn with their peers. Each Den may also meet outside of regular Den meetings for additional events to meet requirements or just for fun. Any such dates and times are determined by the Den Leaders and parents.

Training: Any adult family members participating in activities are *required to complete the Youth Protection Training* online at www.my.scouting.org. Training must be completed within 30 days of any overnight event.

Den Information

The den structure is designed for scouts to be with others in their age group to work together as a team and learn age-appropriate ideas. Some of the topics that the scouts will cover with their den leaders are S.T.E.A.M., creativity, leadership, and working with others.

The den your child will be placed in is based on your child's current grade in school (see chart below). Each year your scout will have new required activities based on their den. Our den leaders will work with the scouts to achieve requirements that can be met during the den meetings, however, some requirements will need to be completed at home. If you complete a requirement at home, please let your den leader know. ScoutBook can be used by parents to check off requirements and upload pictures/documents but will still need to be approved by your den leader before credit is given. The Bobcat badge is an entry badge that will be earned after your scout learns the basics of what it means to be a scout. Your den leader will go over these requirements with you at your first den meeting.

Our den meetings are typically Monday nights at 6:15 pm at Baylake United Methodist Church. Make sure your den leader has your contact information in order to update you if this changes, or if there are any den activities scheduled which may alter the meeting for the week.

Any activities completed during the month by your scouts will be announced at the monthly pack meeting. If your scout has an interest in an elective activity, I encourage you to work with your den leader first as your scout may not be the only one interested. You are always welcome to complete any activities just let your den leader know so they can approve the requirements.
