- Are teachable and willing to be trained to sharpen their ministry skills in working with students
- Are willing to work with the leadership and Origin's elders in order to be united around our ministries' mission.

Process for Joining the Team

We are excited that you desire to join us in ministry to teens and their families. However, there is a process that is required to ensure for us, and you, that this is the place to serve within Origins Church. Please fill out this form and follow the following process to get connected with us. We will do our best to respond in a quick manner to let you know that OC MOVE is the place for you to be.

Process for becoming a student leader

- 1. To serve with OC MOVE you must be a member of Origins Church or have finished the membership class and scheduled for an interview.
- 2. Pick up an MOVE application and covenant from Origins Church.
- 3. Fill out the application; sign the covenant and return to Kevin Jones.
- 4. The application contains a background check to ensure safety for our families and students. When the background check has cleared through the proper channels, an interview will be scheduled with one of our student leaders.
- 5. After the interview, the student leader will connect with the pastor/student pastor overseeing the student ministry to discuss the new applicants.
- 6. Once a decision is made, you will be contacted by phone and informed of the decision.
- 7. Placement within the OC MOVE requires more than an interest in teens. A calling is confirmed through three avenues: opportunity.church-affirmed calling and giftedness. A lack of any of these may prevent a person from acceptance with OC MOVE. For example, you may have been affirmed from the church and you may have the giftedness but there may be too many leaders at the time of your application and therefore, we cannot place you in this ministry. We appreciate your interest and understand that God has given people gifts to serve. We hope that your place of service is with us, but it is also our duty to help guide you away from student ministries if God desires for you to serve in other places within our body.

Interview Questions:

We desire for you to pursue God's course for your life. In your interview with OC MOVE we will center the discussion questions around 6 different areas of ministry and your personal walk with God.

1. How did you come to know Christ? In other words, please share your testimony with us.
2. How are you in community with Origins right now?
3. Tell us about your last church, why did you leave?
4. Do you have the 3 marks of discipleship as described in the Gospel of John?
 Abiding in His Word (John 8:31-32) How is your prayer and personal bible study time? Describe to us what your personal spiritual growth plan looks like?
 Love for your brothers and sisters (John 13:34-35) Is there anyone in your life that you need reconciliation with right now? Who are your closest brothers and sisters? What frustrates you most concerning the church, the body of Christ?
 Bearing fruit (John 15:8, 16) How are you currently working with teens right now? Are you active in sharing your faith with believers and non-believers?
5. Have others in the church affirmed you in your gifting and serving in student ministry?
6. Where are you employed right now and will it hinder your commitment to MOVE Students?
