### **Rehearsal: Thursday, May 15th @ 2:30pm/North Gym**

Prior to the graduation ceremony, we will hold a reception for the 2025 Distinguished Alumni recipient, Mr. Anthony Kosar, in the library. This reception is open to the public if anyone would like to stop down and say hello to Anthony.

### **Graduation: Friday, May 16th at 7:30pm/North Gym**

The graduation ceremony will take place in the North Gym, beginning promptly at 7:30 pm - doors will open at 6:45 p.m. Each graduating senior will receive up to 5 tickets for this event. Students will receive their graduation tickets as part of the checkout process on May 13th. Graduating seniors will need to arrive at the building no later than 6:45pm.

The ceremony will be streamed live on the [Graduation 2025](#) page of the Lisle High School website and will be available on the district's YouTube Channel in the days following the ceremony, so friends and family will be able to access it at their convenience.

Finally, please be aware that there will be no noisemakers, signs, balloons, or any other distractions allowed in the North Gymnasium. Please respect the ceremony and all of the students and families during this special event.

## **IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: CHROMEBOOK MISUSE TREND**

Recently, a concerning and dangerous trend has begun circulating on social media platforms. Videos show individuals inserting objects such as paper clips or pencil graphite into the USB or power ports of Chromebooks in an attempt to create an electrical short circuit. While this behavior may be intended as a prank, it poses serious risks to student safety and can result in significant damage to the devices.

### **Safety Risks**

Inserting metal or other objects into a device's electrical ports can cause sparks, short circuits, or even fires, posing a real danger to students and those nearby.

### **Damage and Cost**

If a student damages their assigned Chromebook or another student's Chromebook as a result of this behavior, a technology charge will be applied to your student's account.

Additionally, please be aware that any student found participating in this type of behavior will face disciplinary action in accordance with our Student Code of Conduct.

We would like to prevent such incidents here in Lisle 202. Please take a moment to speak with your child about the importance of using school-issued devices responsibly and the potential dangers of actions like these. Thank you for your continued partnership in ensuring a safe and productive learning environment for all our students.
