- How to create issue templates
 - Through Github site
 - Configuring issue templates for your repository (github.com)
 - Manually
 - Crate folder called "ISSUE_TEMPLATES"
 - Add markdown files with a YAML header/front matter
 - Example:

 - o name: Bug report
 - o about: Create a report to help us improve
 - o title: "
 - o labels: "
 - o assignees: "
 - **--**-
- Yamil: We can use HTML comments syntax to create instructions for how to use the issue templates, but that will not show up in the resulting issue.
- Advance tricks
 - You can pre-assign "tags" to new issues
 - You can pre-assign a github user/group to new issues


