APPLYING TO DCC - REFERENCE GUIDE

This is a reference guide for students applying to Dutchess Community College. For more information, refer to <u>Applying to College - Step by Step Process</u> posted on Google Classroom.

1. Apply to Dutchess Community College.

Click the link **HERE** to complete the application.

• You do not need recommendation letters or SAT/ACT scores to apply to Dutchess Community College.

2. Add DCC to SCOIR

- Colleges you are applying to should be entered into the "APPLIED" section in SCOIR. This will give your counselor access to submit school documents to these colleges on your behalf.
- Complete the FERPA Release and Waiver

3. Transcript Request Form

- Complete a Transcript Request Form for each college you are applying to.
- This form is used to communicate to your counselor specifically what you need sent to each college so make sure information is accurate and complete.
- A minimum of 2 weeks should be given for school documents to be sent to colleges.

4. FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid

This is the first step for students/families who plan to use financial aid (eg. grants and/or loans) to finance college.

- FAFSA opens October 1st.
- First apply for your FSA ID. Go to:

- The tax information for all guardians will be needed for the prior-prior year (2019 for the class of 2021).
- It's recommended to fill it out as close to October 1, 2020 as possible.
