



HANDYPERSON / MAINTENANCE VOLUNTEER

The Handyman / Maintenance Volunteer plays an important behind-the-scenes role in supporting the daily operations of the RE:center. This position helps maintain a safe, functional, and welcoming environment by completing a variety of repair and maintenance tasks.

Responsibilities may include small building projects, basic repairs, installing fixtures, replacing light bulbs, fixing minor plumbing issues, and supporting general facility upkeep. Volunteers also help identify maintenance needs, communicate supply or tool requirements, and ensure all work areas are clean and safe after each project.

This role requires attention to detail, reliability, and experience using basic tools and equipment. A willingness to serve behind the scenes and take initiative is essential.

Volunteer hours are flexible from Monday through Thursday between 9 am and 4 pm and can be coordinated with the RE:center team based on project needs.

This role may require lifting up to 50 pounds and working in a fast-paced community center environment.

A background check is required.
