### **1. Format Requirements**

**(a) For AI Visual Graphics:** JPG, PNG, or PSD,  $\geq 300$ dpi,  $\leq 200$ MB per image. Must be clear and detailed, showcasing visual creativity and cultural fusion.

**(b) For AI Short Films:** Submissions should have a duration of 30 seconds to 10 minutes, preferably in MP4 or MOV format. Both horizontal and vertical orientations are acceptable. The resolution must meet HD standards or higher, with a focus on visual presentation and cultural expression.

### **2. Subject and Content Requirements**

The submissions must focus on traditional cultural elements of China and Indonesia, with visual creation as the core. Content may incorporate various visual forms, including Graphic design, live-action footage, and animation, to convey the concept of cultural symbiosis between the two nations. Works should be free of cultural bias, respect cultural authenticity, and highlight the creativity and aesthetic appeal of AI-generated visuals.
