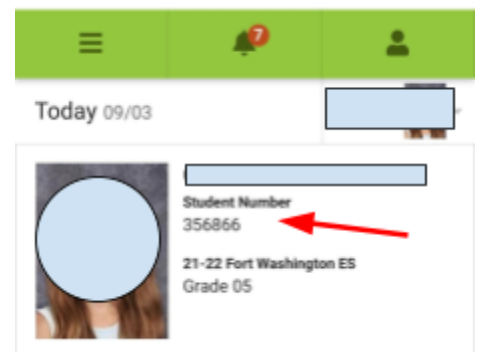
Accessing Clever on a UD Chromebook

To turn on - Simply open the lid or press the power button on the side of the device with the lid opened.

Log in & out - Log into the device using your school email and password (see below for details). Whenever you're done, hold down the power key for a few seconds to log out. Alternatively, you can select "Sign Out" or click the power button from the menu that appears after clicking on the clock in the lower right hand corner of the screen.

The username is the student's full email address - Student emails follow the pattern of the last two digits of their high school graduation year, first initial, last name, @stu.udsd.org. For example Charlie Brown, class of 2030 would be 30cbrown@stu.udsd.org.

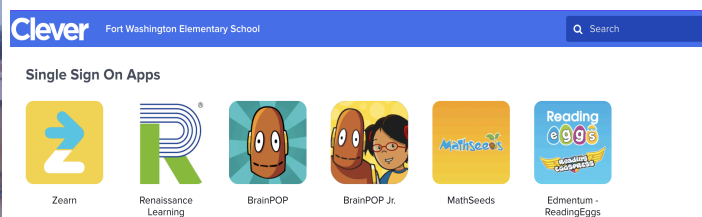
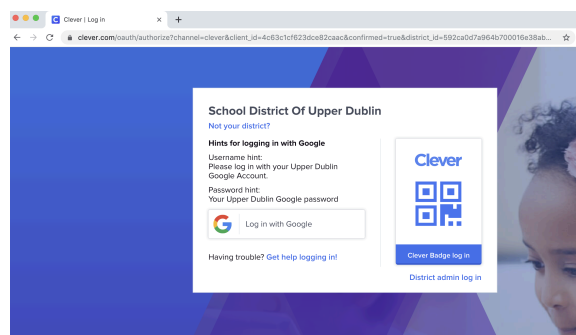
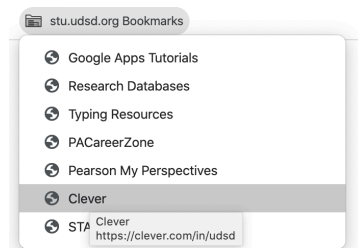
Password pattern for all K-5 students - First name and last name initials (both lowercase) followed by their student ID number. You can find your child's student ID in the [Infinite Campus parent portal](#) by clicking on Today. Their ID will be next to their profile photo (example: Charlie Brown's ID is 123456 so his password would be cb123456.) Passwords are case-sensitive.



If you have any difficulty with your student's username or password, please contact your child's teacher.

Accessing Clever on a UD Chromebook (OR a personal device in which the student is already logged into BOTH the Chrome browser AND their UD account in Google)

1. Once the student has logged into the UD Chromebook and opened the Chrome browser (or, logged into both Chrome **and** their UD account on their personal device) click on “[stu.udsd.org Bookmarks](#)” in the top/left corner.
2. Choose the Clever bookmark; you can also access Clever directly at [Clever.com/in/UDSD](https://clever.com/in/UDSD).
3. On the Clever login screen, click “Log in with Google” and select the UD school account.
4. From the student dashboard, students can access all of their applications, including their teacher’s page.
5. If your student’s teacher has provided a login QR code “badge” (badges are only used for K-1 students) you may also click the “Clever Badge Login” button to login using that method. UD Chromebooks have built-in cameras. If using a personal device, a functional camera is required for this QR code badge login option.

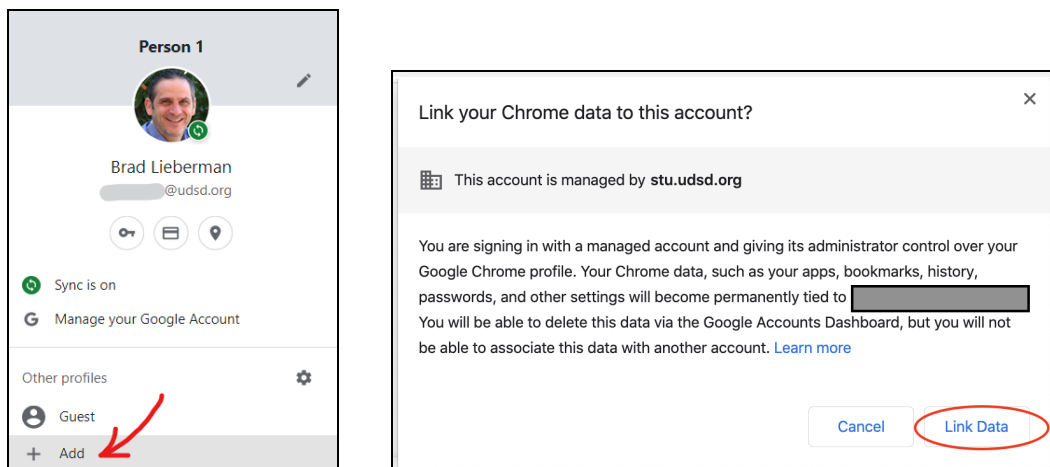


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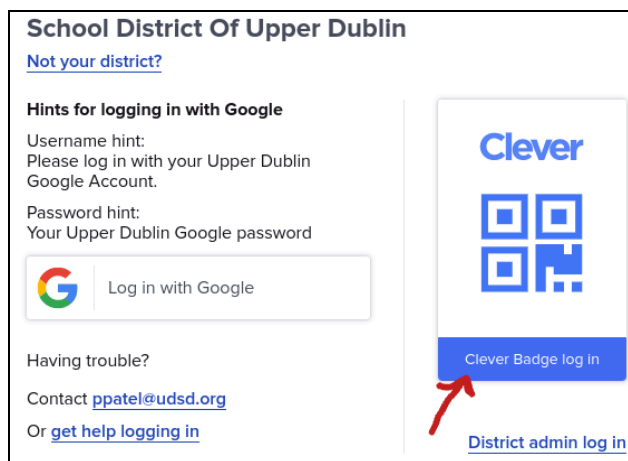
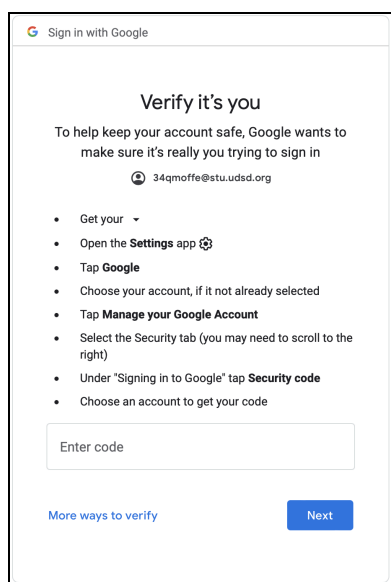
Accessing through a personally-owned device

If using a personal device, make sure to use Chrome and you must first add your child’s profile to the Chrome browser itself. This avoids a potential access error due to other Google accounts being signed into the browser. This step also decreases the odds that you get caught up in a dead-end 2-factor authentication loop prompted by Google (our students do not have 2-factor authentication turned on and the error you might run into is on the following page, “Verify it’s you...”) If Chrome isn’t already installed on your device, click [here](#) to access the download/install page for either PC or Mac.

Add your child's profile - Open Chrome, click the small profile picture in the very top/right corner and select "+ add" at the bottom. Then, sign in with your student's email and password. When prompted, click *link data*, to turn on the sync. Once this has been done, go to [Google.com](https://www.google.com) and log into your student's UD account itself using their username & password, **then access Clever using the directions above.**



Below: Potential 2-factor authentication prompt from Google when trying to log into Clever on your own device (UDSD does NOT have 2FA turned on for our students). *We can't override Google's prompt from our end, and there's no code we can generate to give you so please see the directions above to rectify this issue.* If your personal device at home has a camera and your child's teacher provided you with the QR login badge, logging in through that method will frequently bypass Google's 2FA prompt as well (see image on the right side below.)



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
