Human vs. Al: The Warm Up				
	Facilitator Directions to Participants: "You will be given 60 seconds. With a partner, generate a list of kitchen items."  Facilitator Pauses for Reporting: "How many did you get?"			
Al vs. Human	Launch Your Tool: Facilitator Continues with Directions: "Let's try ChatGPT/Co-Pilot and see how many it comes up with in 60 seconds."

2 Truths and a Lie	Teams use ChatGPT to generate two truths and one lie about a historical figure. Group narrators read each statement to the class. The class will see if they can identify which is the falsehood.			
Talk to a Historical Figure	Prompt: "Generate 2 truths and 1 lie about Abraham Lincoln."  Assume the role of [insert HISTORICAL FIGURE]. Advice from a Time Traveler	What are the challenges and successes with a product, model or idea? Fast forward in time and ask for feedback – or go back and time and analyze.  Prompt: "Assume the personality of William Clay Ford. Become a time traveler and go back in time to provide feedback on the Edsel model of car. Share the challenges or successes and make recommendations for improvement."  Prompt: "Assume that you are Elon Musk and travel back in time to the 1960's in a 7th grade classroom Explain what is coming around space exploration between 1960 and 2024. Share his space exploration program and how they can pay to go to space in the future"

Mimic the Style	Upload a writing sample, an image, or provide details about the intended style. Ask the Al generator to mimic.  Prompt: "Mimic the style of Claude Monet and create a watercolor of the Florida Keys".  Prompt: "Mimic the style of Jimmy Buffett and write a song about the Florida Keys."  Prompt: "Mimic the writing style of J.K. Rowling and the Harry Potter series and craft a 750 word short story about a young Irish girl who gets shipped off to boarding school by a mean stepmother."
Bionic and Super Human	Improve answers by asking the AI Generator to become super human or bionic and improve the results. You can prompt by asking it to use more precise, technical, professional, or educational language.  Prompt: "Explain in 250 words how force and motion work. Additional Prompt: Assume the role of a super human and improve the previous answer."
Back to the Future	Project the future about a topic.  Prompt: "Write a futuristic headline about [insert topic] that is funny and outrageous"

Act Like A Tutor	In anticipation of a quiz, ask the AI generator to spend 5 minutes tutoring on a topic.  Prompt: "Act like a tutor who is an expert about MUSIC HISTORY. Quiz me about what I know"

	Transform your words into an entertaining idea.			
Call in Sick To Work	List excuses for calling in sick to work, or create a humorous story about why a famous character will miss work. Have participants vote on the best/funniest result.  Prompt: Share 10 excuses for missing work that sound valid and plausible.  Prompt: "Create a humorous story for cartoon character Fred Flintstone's boss Mr. Slate detailing the reason why Fred will not be at work at his job at the Bedrock Quarry."			
Generate Fake News for a Social Media Post	Use an LLM like ChatGPT to create a fake news post, humorous story, or challenge post for "Fake Book" in social media format to inspire conversation. Extend to create a visual in Canva Al Magic Tools or another multimedia generator. Next, have the class FLUF Test each of the infographics to see if you can spot the hallucinations.  Examples:  • Fake News or Joke - Craft an "April Fool's Day" post for social media • Fill in the blank – My favorite [insert TOPIC] is • Challenge – create an image of you enjoying your favorite thing • Nostalgia – "Think back [to WHEN] what was your favorite [insert OBJECT]growing up?"			
Create a Fairy Tale	Use the "Storyteller" in Gravity Write, or your favorite LLM (Copilot, ChatGPT, etc.).  Prompt: Create a fairytale using five of your favorite things [food, colors, cars, places, hobby for example].			
Retell the Story	Use Gamma to create a presentation that retells a fairy tale like Cinderella, The Three Little Pigs, or Peter and the Wolf.  Prompt: Retell the story of the fairytale Cinderella using pizza, flipflops, the beach, Jimmy Buffett, and a margarita.  Sample Gamma  Or - change the spin and ask it to create a presentation that tells the story of force and motion, UN SDGs, or a topic that you teach. Did it get it right?			

Prompt to Visual Imagery  Transform your words into visually appealing content with AI.		
DallE-3 Self Portraits	You will be given 3 minutes. Create a self-portrait by describing yourself. Tweak the results by giving the prompt more information like, "rounder face" or "darker skin".  Think/Pair/Share with a partner.  Prompt: "Create a self-portrait of a red headed woman in her mid-fifties with a round face and sparkling green eyes wearing a navy blue suit and white shirt and tortoise-shell glasses"  Extensions: Students upload the selfies as profile pics on their Canvas courses. Students upload to Canvas in the Discussion Board alongside a real picture and ask for comments using accountable talk. Think/Pair/Share in person and ask for suggestions about prompting. Post the printed images around the room and use sticky notes to vote for the best one, or guess who it is.

Prompt to Music, Image, or Video				
Transform your words into multiple media formats.				
Teach Me About Music	Using the GPT "Music Teacher", learn something you've always wanted to know about music. Consider learning an instrument, about theory or scales, or have it write a song for you in a particular genre.			
	Using characters from the movie [insert MOVIE NAME], generate a video script for a 3-5 minute video that teaches [insert TOPIC].			
Write a Video Script Using a Movie Theme	Prompt: "Using the characters from Indiana Jones, create a 5-minute video script for a webinar workshop series around educational technology featuring Jennifer and Kate. The topics will include AI generation using images, presentations, ethics, copyright, critical evaluation, and multimedia."			
	Challenge the attendees to generate a song based on a current topic or subject that is circling around their heads.			
Create a Song, Album Cover, and Video	Consider creating the lyrics in ChatGPT, Gravity Write, or your favorite AI platform.
