BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

Please briefly present the organisation.

Quality in Social Responsibility Association (Turkish: Sosyal Sorumlulukta Kalite Derneği) (SSKD) was established in 2018, located in İzmir/Türkiye by a group of youth workers, officers, and academicians in order to enhance the quality of implementation in social responsibility and related areas.

Aim: To create a stronger civil society by enhancing the quality of initiatives organized in the field of social responsibility.

Objectives:

1. Establishing a Quality Infrastructure: To create the necessary infrastructure and undertake inclusive standardization/procedural work for actors involved in the field of social responsibility to approach their initiatives with a specific focus on quality.
2. Promoting Quality: Promote the widespread adoption of best practices based on the perspective of solidarity underlying social responsibility.
3. Strengthening for Quality: Enable the empowerment of civil society and enhance the impact of its initiatives by establishing the necessary infrastructure for systematic transformation.
4. Building a Culture of Quality: Create awareness of the need for quality in the field of social responsibility, shape and guide this area, shape the future, and make quality an integral part of social responsibility.
5. Continuous Improvement: Encourage the alignment of initiatives in the field of social responsibility with the current era and promote their continuous development through research and development activities.

We are aiming to establish new partnerships with individuals and organizations who are working in the social responsibility field, take responsibility to be executive, and develop their quality and activities, which will be implemented via different techniques.

We have an experienced team for implementing projects, selecting participants based on the target group profile, ensuring effective communication, and disseminating/exploiting project results to various people and organizations. ,

We are member of a local network that includes 200+ NGOs from different fields. In addition, we have good connections with local administrations (İzmir Governorship and İzmir Metropolitan Municipality) for supporting local activities and attending decision-making meetings.

Furthermore, we have organized more than 10+ Erasmus+ KA1 and/or KA2 projects and attended more than 20+ international projects with 60+ participants.

We are an active organization who organizes local, national, and international activities like meetings, seminars, congresses, and international projects. We share our knowledge with local people and decision-makers (local administrators, politicians, etc.).

What are the activities and experiences of the organization in the areas relevant to this application?

We started the youth work field in 2010 as an informal youth group (aktiF-Iz Youth Community – aktif-iz.org). We have applied and organized 12 projects. We have built a partnership in 15 countries in more than 20.

As an informal group, in 2014 we started to organize the National Social Responsibility Projects' Congress (SSPKONGRE) which aims to increase the quality of implementation of all kinds of projects in the social responsibility area. In 2019, we organized 5th of SSPKONGRE and we hosted 78 good project examples and more than 1500 pax involved. We published a proceedings book after every SSPKONGRE (<https://sspkongre.sskd.org.tr/bildirilerkitabi/>)

To enhance Congress's power, we established SSKD in 2018.
