

SnowBrawl 2026 FAQs

What if there's weather and stuff going on?

You're adults, make adult decisions. Please leave plenty of time for travel under whatever conditions may occur. If you're running late, that may affect your team and you may lose points or even forfeit your first set/match. That sucks but it's not worth putting yourself in danger. Again, make adult decisions.

What is the refund policy if I decide to drop?

There are no refunds this close to the tournament.

Where do I sign in for the tournament?

Captains may pick up their rosters at the main hall entrance(facing the Omni). That sign in table will be available at about 1 hour before the start of the tournament each day and will be open at least one hour past the start of the tournament (7 am - 9:15 am Saturday and 7 a.m. - 9:15 a.m. Sunday).

ADULT Player Entry

All Rostered players will receive a QR code (likely the day before the tournament). That QR code along with your government issued ID, we gain you access to the exhibition hall. That QR code and ID will be needed EACH time you enter the hall. No exceptions.

What will my team need to provide for a work team?

We may have supervisor refs/court managers walking around and assigned to courts HOWEVER, you'll need to provide a FULL work team including an up ref, down ref, two lines people, one score flipper/libero tracker, and a scorekeeper. We should have certified refs to cover all play offs rounds.

What are the uniform rules?

The SnowBrawl tournament is designated as a “relaxed uniform” tournament. Teams playing at all levels (as well as the other levels) are required to follow Yankee Uniform rules set forth in the [Rules and Policies](#) document.

When and Where is the players party?

There will be NO formal players party this year. Dave and Busters is still available however we will NOT have a private room and will NOT have drink/game tickets. Sorry!

Who do I call if I'm running late?

First off, shame on you. Second, the sign in table will be available until 9:15am on Saturday and Sunday.

I can't update my roster!?!

Only the Captain of the team can update the roster. If you are the captain, be sure that you are logged into the yankee site. If you have additional issues with the site, email info@yankee.org. If your roster has changes that are not on the PRINTED roster you MUST notify the tournament directors at sign-in. Full rosters should be updated on line ONE WEEK

prior to the tournament. Changes you make the week before the tournament should also be e-mailed to mark@nevolleyball.org. If you have a change during the tournament you MUST notify the tournament directors at the tournament desk for signoff. It is solely your responsibility to keep your roster within tournament limits and abide by all tournament rules.

What time will the tournament be finished?

Saturday tournament will begin at 8am and run until roughly 7:30pm. Sunday will begin at 8am and run through about 5pm. If you plan to win a lot, you'll be there longer.

All teams will make playoffs either going to the gold bracket, or the silver bracket.

What kinds of food, etc. can I bring with me?

Facility Rules:

- Coolers and outside food and drink are NOT ALLOWED in the convention center.
- Alcohol is NOT ALLOWED inside the exhibition hall.
- Warm up music/sound systems are NOT ALLOWED.
- Only water and sports drinks may be brought inside the facility.
- There are food options within the Convention Center and nearby options surrounding the Convention Center.
- There will be chairs around the courts--you may NOT bring in your own chairs.

Other information:

- There will be a NO TOLERANCE policy for misbehavior by players/teams and spectators in the venues.

- Ball Handling is NOT allowed outside of the exhibit halls in the convention center.
- There will be an athletic trainer available.
