We are pleased to send you some updates on the registration process for the *XIX Jornadas de Bizancio* (XIX Conference on Byzantine Studies) of the Spanish Society of Byzantine Studies (SEB) on 24-27 January 2022 at the *Universidad Complutense de Madrid*.

1) Registration's fee

a) Until September 30 (2021):

- 20 euros: SEB's members.
- 25 euros: non-member students (with a valid ID).
- 50 euros: non-member professors and researchers.


b) Until October 31 (2021):

- 30 euros: SEB's members.
- 35 euros: non-member students (with a valid ID).
- 60 euros: non-member professors and researchers.

c) Deal: inscription's fee with SEB's one year membership included (2022's fee; promotion valid until September 30 [2021]):*

- 30 euros: for non-member students (with a valid ID).
