



Hawthorne Uniform Policy 2021-2022

Bottoms: All bottoms must be solid khaki, brown, blue, gray or black.

- a. Uniform pants
- b. Uniform shorts/skirts/jumpers must be fingertip-length
- c. Tights or leggings may **ONLY** be worn beneath uniform pants or skirts
- d. Tights or leggings **MUST** be solid uniform khaki, brown, blue, gray or black

Tops: All tops must be a solid color. No logos, designs, embroidery, embellishments other than Hawthorne or Warren Township labels.

- e. Short sleeved or long sleeved shirts with a collar must be worn at all times
- f. Sweaters, Sweater Vests, Cardigans permitted
- g. Uniform compliant crewneck sweatshirts may be worn at all times
- h. Hooded sweatshirts may only be worn in the classroom.

Reminders:

- No jeans or denim.
- Any sweaters, sweatshirts, or sweater vests **MUST** have a solid-colored, collared shirt underneath.
- All clothing is to be logo-free with the exception of the Hawthorne or Warren Township logo.
- All uniform clothing must be solid colors only.
- Shirts should be tucked in if possible.
- If pants or shorts have a belt loop, a belt should be worn.

The Board of Education believes that how students dress has a positive effect upon student learning and the atmosphere of a school. Research and the experience of school systems that have adopted a school **uniform** policy indicate improvement in achievement, attendance, behavior, and overall school spirit.
