The 5 Best Glass Bongs and Water Pipes: The Top Reviewed of 2022

Other than joints, glass bongs and water pipes are one of the most popular ways you can consume weed (hey, if you need rolling papers, don't miss out on our great selection at Headshop). Bongs offer flavorful, powerful hits that are kinder to your lungs. Who doesn't love that?! But you should know that not all glass bongs are created equal.

If you're on the hunt for a new bong or looking for a special piece to add to your smoking collection, then you're in luck. We reviewed a variety of leading industry pieces to find the best glass bongs and water pipes of 2022.

To get your hands on the highest quality glass bong, we reviewed everything for you. Like how cool and smooth the bong hits were and how optimal the filtration was, plus we verified if the bong was made of premium borosilicate glass.

What is a Bong?

A bong is a large water pipe like a <u>hookah</u>, but it's smaller and comes in countless variations. Basically, it's an airtight vessel with an added bowl and stem that guides air down below the water until it bubbles upward during use. Most bongs have a hole called a carburetor or carb that's covered during the smoking process but then allowed to open to draw the smoke into your lungs. In bongs without a carb, the bowl and/or the stem are removed instead.

To smoke a bong, you light up the dry herb first. Then as you pull from the bong, the bubbling starts. The water and bubbles act as filtration for the smoke, cooling the smoke down, and reducing toxins. By the time the smoke passes through the bong into your lungs, it will be filtered, cool, and smooth.

How Does a Bong Work?

The key purpose of a bong or water pipe is to filter out harmful toxins. The water filtration from a bong filters out approximately 90% of the toxins. So, a bong filters the smoke for toxins and then cools the smoke as it travels through the bong water, bubbles, and ice into your lungs. The water, bubbles, and ice act as cooling surface areas that the smoke travels through before it reaches your lungs. The cooler the smoke, the less harsh the hits, and the kinder it is to your lips, mouth, and lungs.

What Makes a Quality Glass Bong?

If you haven't found the quality bong of your dreams yet, this section will help you understand what we look for in a premium quality bong so you can make the best purchase for yourself.

Quality Bongs Use Thick Borosilicate Glass

Laboratory science-grade glass equipment is made of borosilicate glass. Because it's thermal resistant, it can tolerate temperature fluctuations without any damage. Many of the bongs that are made in China and sold here in the USA are NOT 100% borosilicate glass. If your bong shatters when it falls, that indicates that your bong was cheaply made. Premium quality glass won't shatter. Instead, it will split in two. Look for borosilicate glass at least 4mm thick and up. While 3mm and less is much cheaper and will still work, we suggest at least 4mm in glass thickness if you want your bong to last for years.

Quality Bongs Offer Efficient Filtration

The main purpose of a bong is filtration! By filtering out all the toxins, a bong will primarily deliver THC. There are no strict regulations in the cannabis industry compared to the tobacco industry, but we expect to see more regulations when it comes to filtration. A bong requires great water filtration (never smoke from a dry bong)! Look for a bong that can hold water and a downstem that has holes or slits that will create bubbles for more filtration and cooling.

Quality Bongs Cool Down the Smoke

Another major factor is cooling. As more states legalize recreational marijuana, smoking weed has become more and more popular. The cooler the smoke, the less harsh your inhalations will be. We've all experienced bad coughing fits and it's something you really should avoid. It's just unhealthy. A bong with an ice pinch will help cool down the smoke even further. The optimal cooling feature is glycerin coils but a great perc in the water filtration chamber does a fine job too.

3 Benefits of Glass Bongs

We believe that the best glass bongs are those made of borosilicate glass. Borosilicate glass is a high-quality glass that contains silica and boron trioxide. Keep reading for 3 benefits of glass bongs that you might not know.

1. Borosilicate Glass Bongs Can Withstand Thermal Shock

High-quality bongs typically have around 15% boron trioxide. The secret that makes a bong thermal shock resistant is by changing the chemical properties of glass with boron trioxide. For example, if you poured boiling water into a bong with 15% boron trioxide and then put it into the freezer, it wouldn't crack. So, if you want the best bong or water pipe, get one that can withstand thermal shock.

2. Borosilicate Glass Bongs are Resistant to Chemical Leaching

There's another awesome benefit of borosilicate glass bongs. Because of the boron trioxide, the glass is less soluble. This means that the glass itself is resistant to chemicals leaching into the glass. This is important because dirty bong water can become a breeding ground for nasty germs. You'll have peace of mind knowing that when you clean your bong it will be chemically clean too.

3. The Hits from Borosilicate Glass Bongs Taste Better

Not only is borosilicate glass resistant to chemical leaching and degradation from acid, but they also make your precious weed taste much better. In comparison to metal, silicone, and acrylic water pipes, borosilicate glass offers the most natural flavor with your weed. The best clean bong will allow you to enjoy all the delicate terpene flavor profiles without any interference.

FAQs

Are water pipes better than dry pipes?

It depends on the situation and your personal preference. For example, bongs are typically larger than dry pipes or hand pipes, which can make them challenging to conceal or travel with discreetly. They also take more time to set up and clean. In addition, water pipes are often more expensive than dry pipes.

However, it should be noted that most experienced smokers have both water pipes and dry pipes in their collection because they like to switch things up using different smoking methods.

One more thing to consider is the type of smoking experience you want. If you prefer a cooler, smoother, more filtered hit with more smoke and fewer toxins, a bong would be your go-to. But if you just want a guick hit, hand pipes are the way to go.

Why do people prefer bongs?

- Smooth hits
- Larger hits
- Conserve weed

Some users claim the high they get from smoking a bong over a dry pipe is quicker, lasts longer, and is more euphoric. Others prefer bongs because they are a cleaner and safer way to smoke.

How long do bongs last?

This depends a lot on its cleaning and maintenance. Premium quality bongs can last 5 to 10 years or even a lifetime if you take good care of them which means cleaning them regularly, not leaving them around kids or pets, not bringing them to parties, and putting them away when they're not in use. It all depends on how you treat your bong, along with a little luck.

How To Use a Bong

5 Simple Steps to Use a Bong:

- 1. Put your dry herb in the bowl chamber
- 2. Add water into the beaker base
- 3. Light up your dry herb while inhaling
- 4. Lift the bowl up (where your dry herb is)
- 5. Inhale the smoke in the bong

Detailed Instructions

With your dry herb in the bowl chamber and water in the base at the recommended level, here's a detailed breakdown of everything you need to do for the most amazing bong hits:

- Start by sitting in a comfortable position with your bong in front of you on a table or an
 even surface. You should be able to hold the bong firmly around the smoke chamber or
 from the bottom.
- 2. Put your lips inside the mouthpiece (not outside), while sealing the opening with your hand.
- 3. We suggest taking a few deep breaths before lighting up your dry herb. Filling your lungs with air will make smoking much smoother.

- 4. With your lighter tilted horizontally, touch the flame at the edge of the bowl. Your dry herb will last longer if you don't hold the flame too close to the bowl.
- 5. Gradually inhale while continuing to light the bowl. You will see the chamber filling with smoke (beginners should fill the chamber only halfway with smoke).
- 6. When you see the dry herb glowing and the bowl filled with smoke, remove the lighter while keeping your mouth on the mouthpiece.
- 7. Now, remove your hand from the opening and inhale deeply. Hold the smoke in your lungs for a few seconds and then exhale. Repeat this process for the remaining smoke in the chamber.

Bong Do's and Don'ts

Do's

- 1. Do add kief to the bowl in your next smoking session. This tip will change your life!
- 2. Do use a bowl screen. It will filter and trap tiny particles that could otherwise end up in your mouth.
- 3. Do watch water levels. The downstem should be submerged in water and the percolator should be in water for bongs with multiple percolators.

Don'ts

- Don't under-grind or over-grind your weed. The more surface area your weed has, the more even the burn.
- 2. Don't pack too much weed in the bowl. Ideally, weed will cover the whole area of the bowl but not compacted so tightly that it blocks the airflow.
- 3. Don't put alcohol or bleach on mouthpieces, tubing, rubber gaskets, or any other parts that come into contact with your mouth.

Tips

- 1. When smoking a bong, breathe deeply and slowly. Practice deep breathing before you pick up your bong and take your first hit.
- 2. You can break up dry herb with your fingers or scissors, but having a grinder is essential for the most even burn.
- 3. Use an ice bong, percolator, or ash catcher to cool down the smoke.

- 4. When it comes to the bong bowl, size matters a lot. If you want larger hits, you should use a small bowl. If you want smaller hits, use a large bowl.
- 5. Instead of removing the bowl all at once, remove it gradually. This will introduce the smoke at a reasonable pace that your lungs can more easily receive.
- 6. To prevent throat irritation and wasting dry herb, end your hits with a breath of air.

 This will propel the smoke into your lungs.
- 7. Any residual smoke that is not exhaled will result in a coughing fit, so exhale the smoke with some force. You can also exhale half of the smoke, take a short breath, and exhale the rest.

How Much Does a Bong Cost?

If you're a first-time buyer, it can be intimidating to purchase a bong. A bong can cost anywhere from \$20 to \$650 and more depending on what features you're looking for and where you shop. Many users don't have the budget to drop \$650 on a bong; however, it's important to buy a bong that has most of the features you want.

In general, users want a bong that offers the best hits so they can get the most out of their weed. Yes, you can get large multi-chamber bongs with all the bells and whistles. The reality is that every bong has its own pros and cons, and you can easily find a good bong that hits well without breaking your budget.

Breakdown By Price Range

It is possible to find a decent bubbler for about \$20 that hits well.

If you're willing to drop \$20 to \$80, the selection is much better. You'll find larger and more durable glass bongs. Some will include percolation, often in the form of a downstem with slits in it. With regular maintenance, these bongs can last a lifetime.

If you can spend \$80 to \$250, you're going to find bongs with more complex features. Features can include larger size, better materials, multiple chambers for increased percolation, and ice pinches. These bongs are typically made of borosilicate glass which is thicker and not as fragile.

For any bong that costs more than \$250, you'll find high-end design, multiple state-of-the-art features, and many accessories. Some bongs even serve as functional art.

I Got My Bong, What Else Do I Need?

When it comes to a highly effective way to smoke weed, it's hard to beat a bong for ease and convenience. Bongs or water pipes offer powerful yet smooth rips by filtering the smoke through water. But you can enhance your smoking experience even further by customizing your bong with accessories of all kinds.

Some accessories will make your bong hits even smoother and more powerful. Some make using and cleaning your bong more convenient. Some can transform your bong into a dab rig for the strongest hits ever. Keep reading for some of our favorite bong accessories.

1. Bowl

Available in various shapes and sizes, the <u>bowl</u> is where you put your weed and light it. Some bongs have bowls that are large enough and wide enough to pack a lot of weed for more powerful hits. Some bowls are just made of better material that can withstand high temperatures and make lighting up even easier.

While many bongs already include good bowls, you can buy bowl attachments that offer a better smoking experience, while others just look awesome in your bong. A bowl is one of the coolest accessories if you want to personalize your bong.

2. Quartz Banger

If you want to really upgrade your smoking sessions, you might want to try using a <u>quartz</u> <u>banger</u>. Also known as a dab nail, a quartz banger is a part like a bowl but it's deeper and protrudes out from your bong. It's typically made with materials such as quartz that can withstand higher temperatures than glass without cracking.

Some people like to heat a quartz banger with a blow torch because the quartz won't crack. Just use a dab of your favorite concentrate when the quartz banger is red hot for an intense hit.

3. Percolator

If you'd like to make your bong hits cooler and smoother, then consider adding a <u>percolator</u> or perc to your bong. A perc is an attachment that helps cool the smoke down before it reaches your mouth. Percs are available in different forms, like chambers or little holes that the smoke travels through which cools it down nicely.

You can get percolator attachments for your bong, but we've found that it works best to get a bong that has a built-in perc. This way, your hits are guaranteed to be super satisfying. Once you try a perc with your bong, you just might be hooked for life.

4. Ash Catcher

Another accessory that really enhances your bong is an <u>ash catcher</u>. This stops any unwanted ash from getting into your bong and makes your hits so much smoother and even more satisfying. Some come with percolators to enhance your hits even further.

Using an ash catcher is easy. Just slot one into the stem of your bong, then attach your bowl to the ash catcher for some of the smoothest and freshest hits. This accessory is easy to use and inexpensive, so it's worth trying.

5. Diffused Downstem

Another part of your bong is the downstem, connecting the bowl to the chamber. Although some downstems are built into the bong, you can also get downstem attachments to further customize your bong.

A <u>diffused downstem</u> will really enhance your hits. It will also aerate your hits before the smoke reaches the chamber which results in some of the strongest hits. They're easy to attach to any bong and even easier to clean.

6. Bowl Screen

If you use your bong often, it gets dirty very quickly. The resin from burnt weed quickly accumulates in your bowl which can be hard to avoid unless you're cleaning it well after every use. Or you could use a bowl screen.

<u>Bowl screens</u> are little metal screens or filters that fit any kind of bowl. Just put a screen into your bowl before you light up your weed and it will help make cleaning your bong much easier.

7. Grinder

A grinder is just one of those essential accessories. Whether you're smoking a joint or a bong, your hits will be that much better if you grind your weed first.

Putting properly ground weed in your bong bowl makes lighting up easier for much better hits. It will also prevent resin build-up to a certain extent because there won't be chunks of ash and burnt weed. If you don't have one, get yourself a <u>grinder</u> at Headshop ASAP!

8. Cleaner

No matter what, you're always going to need to clean your bong. Bacteria, tar, and mold quickly build up in your bong and the glass gets covered with resin, so make sure you thoroughly clean your bong regularly.

While rinsing out your bong water under a hot tap helps remove some surface dirt, you should give it a deep clean as soon as you can. You can use isopropyl alcohol for glass bongs, as noted below in How To Clean a Bong or you can use a special bong cleaner to keep your piece looking as good as new.

Bong Pros and Cons

What are the Pros?

- 1. The water traps and prevents water-soluble molecules, heavier particles, and toxins from entering your lungs which gives a cleaner and smoother smoke.
- 2. As tar is separated from the smoke, it builds up on the inside of the bong instead of being inhaled.
- 3. Compared to other devices, bongs provide more powerful hits.

- 4. The water cools the smoke which makes it easier to inhale. You can even get ice bongs that cool down the smoke even further.
- 5. Bongs are easy to use and easy to clean (usually).
- 6. Some bongs can be customized to reflect your personality.

What are the Cons?

- The water filtration also traps THC. Per a <u>NORML-MAPS study</u> in 2000, "water pipes filter out more psychoactive THC than they do other tars, thereby requiring users to smoke more to reach their desired effect."
- 2. Some glass bongs are fragile and break easily.
- 3. Large bongs are not easily portable and can even be cumbersome.
- 4. The bong water needs to be changed often or it will smell and taste nasty.

How to Clean a Bong

Bongs are awesome, but a filthy bong with foul-smelling resin, mold, and tar, not so much.

Learn how to clean a bong and how to clean your glass bong type in a safe and affordable way.

Cleaning your bong is absolutely necessary to remove the resin, mold, and tar buildup that occurs in a bong.

Resin can cause significant lung issues if you inhale it too often. Mold and tar are also seriously unhealthy. A bong <u>filter</u> helps, but it can only do so much.

If you use your bong on the regular like we do, then you'll need to clean it fairly often. We'll show you how to clean a glass bong below.

Why You Should Clean Your Bong Every Day

If you'd like to keep your bong looking like new, then clean it every day. The built-up resin will harden, making it more difficult to remove if you wait too long between cleanings.

Also, your bong won't be as effective if you wait too long to clean it. That resin that builds up on the inside of the glass makes smoking harder until it might even become impossible.

Resin also affects how well the smoke is being filtered which degrades the taste and smoothness. If you're a heavy smoker, we suggest daily cleaning of your water pipe (or at least changing the dirty bong water) if you want to enjoy all those terpene profiles.

How Do You Know If Your Bong Should Be Cleaned?

You can tell that your water pipe needs some TLC if there is any residue buildup or discoloration on the inside of the glass.

If you try to smoke from a bong that has resin, mold, and tar built up, it will be more difficult for the smoke to pass through the water and filter out any toxins without getting even dirtier – yuck!

What Happens If You Don't Clean Your Bong?

If you don't clean your bong regularly, it will start to look brown and filthy, and it will smell foul. Disgusting bacteria and mold will form on the surface of your bong.

If you use a bong covered in built-up residue, mold, and tar, not only will it be hard for the smoke to move through the water and effectively filter out any toxins without getting dirty, but there is also the possibility of getting a nasty infection from all the microbial growth in the dirty bong water.

How Do You Clean a Glass Bong?

You can easily clean a glass bong using salt and alcohol (or vinegar, tea tree oil, or olive oil) to break down any residue in your bong.

Another option is using a <u>special bong cleaner</u>. A bong cleaner will help you keep your glass pieces fresh and clean, plus it's super convenient to use.

5 Steps to Clean a Glass Bong WITH Alcohol

- 1. Fill the glass bong with warm water and a little dish detergent. Then cover the openings and shake. Pour out the water and allow the glass piece to air dry.
- 2. Fill the bong chamber with isopropyl or rubbing alcohol with some coarse salt (around 1/4 of the amount of alcohol).
- 3. You can cover the openings using Saran wrap and rubber bands.
- 4. Shake the bong vigorously. Allow the bong sit with the alcohol and salt overnight, shaking it periodically.
- 5. Pour the dirty water out and rinse the bong with warm water. Allow your clean bong to air dry. If needed, you can go back and detail any areas of the bong with a Q-tip and more alcohol.

Tip: Use a Zip-Lock bag with the method above for smaller pieces like your bowl and downstem. After rinsing, dry with a paper towel.

5 Steps to Clean a Glass Bong WITHOUT Alcohol

- 1. Fill the glass bong with warm water and some dish detergent. Then cover the openings and shake. Pour out the water and allow the glass piece to air dry.
- 2. Fill the bong chamber with vinegar mixed with water and baking soda. Then add some coarse salt (around 1/4 of the amount of alcohol).
- 3. You can cover all the openings using Saran wrap and rubber bands.

- 4. Shake your bong vigorously. Allow the bong to sit with the vinegar, baking soda, and salt overnight, shaking it periodically.
- 5. Pour the dirty water out and rinse the bong with warm water. Allow your clean bong to air dry. If needed, you can detail any areas of the bong with a Q-tip and more vinegar and baking soda.

Tip: Use a Zip-Lock bag with the method above for smaller pieces like your bowl and downstem. After rinsing, dry with a paper towel.

Benefits of Cleaning a Bong

There are many benefits of cleaning a bong. The primary reason you should clean your bong is because resin, mold, and tar can be extremely unhealthy.

Resin contains toxins known to cause cancer, and tar has carcinogenic properties too. Mold is also dangerous because the mold releases spores that can cause serious health issues.

You don't want any of the bad stuff in there while you're inhaling smoke into your lungs in what should be one of the most enjoyable experiences of your life. So, just use a clean bong to prevent the bad stuff from happening!

It Makes the Hits Tastier

Not only will cleaning your bong make the hits tastier, but they will also smell better. If you have a buildup of resin and tar in your piece, any rips you get from such a dirty bong will release toxins into your smoke, causing a nasty aftertaste. This is less likely to happen the more often you clean your bong.

It's Kinder to Your Lungs

You'll be kinder to your lungs using a clean bong. If you smoke from a dirty bong, your lungs could be filled with toxins that can lead to respiratory issues associated with tar and other

byproducts of resin burned in weed pipes. In addition, if you're sharing your bong with friends without cleaning it first, you could even spread respiratory infections like colds or flu.

It Can Prevent Infections

As noted above, those who smoke from a dirty bong are more likely to get respiratory issues and infections. You should clean your bong at least every day or even more depending on how often you use it.

Are There Any Precautions When Cleaning a Bong?

Be careful when cleaning a bong because during the process you might inhale vapors that could be toxic. So, take precautionary measures such as wearing a mask, and not cleaning in closed spaces. Also, if you just cleaned your bong with alcohol, be sure to rinse it thoroughly and allow it to air dry before using again.

Ultimately, when it comes to cleaning a bong, it all comes down to a healthy lifestyle and being kind to your lungs. Smoking weed with a clean bong will prevent you from breathing in tar and other harmful toxins that can damage your lungs.

Bigger isn't always better! We found that the Str8 Brand 5" Mini Water Rig gave us the smooth, filtered hits we love, thanks to its fixed showerhead percolator. You know, it works by drawing the smoke through these openings at the bottom of the tube into the main chamber before moving through the mouthpiece.
