Ranger Roadster Project – Jerry Day built a unique Sprint Car and documented the build in 35 installments running from May 2012 in *Vintage Oval Racing* to March 2015 in *Victory Lane*. As outlined in Part 1, Day's build was inspired by cars raced by Del Fanning and Lee Dunavelt in the northwestern United States circa 1960. Bearing no resemblance to a

traditional Sprint Car, Day's creation uses a Ranger aircraft engine laid on its side to lower the center of gravity in the manner of the Roadsters that raced at Indianapolis during the late 1950s and early 1960s.

Jalopies, Roadsters *Jalopy and Roadster racing was popular in the early 1950s and earlier.*

Jalopies were crude, stripped-down passenger cars, sometimes little more than a frame and engine on wheels, and this type of racing was highly informal. Roadsters were generally better crafted, open cars that competed at established racetracks and evolved into, or were replaced by Sprint Cars and hardtop Stock Cars. Many Roadster alumni graduated to top-level racing at Indianapolis and elsewhere.
