Personality

He is a grouchy, stern dragon. Boisterous, arrogant, and near manic at times, he's almost intolerable to be around. Hanging onto the old legacy of his former clan, he is constantly bragging about this. He's explosive in all emotions, notably in anger and desperation, which can cause violent outbursts. Emotionally unstable, he can't seem to keep any relationship of any kind except for a very small handful. He can be extremely focused on any goal of his and anything that will help with his goals. Loyal and obedient to those of authority, he is willing to do whatever it takes to get what he desires.

With the few that can stand him, he is cheerful, optimistic, and supportive in any way possible.

History

Birth to Clan Disbandment (2890-2912)

Bhaumiula was born five years after his older brother, Lohenus, with the intended purpose of becoming the Clan's ambassador. Very early on, he was enamored by his clan lifestyle and his own clan, proud to have been born into it. Despite the clear and obvious problems his clan was going through, he was unbothered by the deterioration, confident in his father's ability to have the clan survive.

He and his brother Lohenus were close as children, helping each other impress their father and in general being each other's best company. The pressures they felt were heavy, but less so with the other's support. As they grew, Lohenus started to experience more and more stress as the clan's heir, while Bhaumiula became focused on helping the clan out with his future ambassador status. The overwhelming demands and quickening internal collapse were far too much for dragons as young as they both were, but while Lohenus started to break under the pressure, Bhaumiula continued on. While the two were still close, this began their arguments, as Lohenus wanted nothing more than to rest, and Bhaumiula wanted nothing more than to keep going.

Sadly, his efforts, as the efforts of everyone else in the clan, were for nothing, as the council voted to strip their status due to their lackluster achievements. This devastated him and his father, who soon quickly ran into the night and disappeared, unable to handle it. Bhaumiula helped form a search for his father, Lohenus excluding himself from the search, but they found nothing. In the end, the family scattered, with almost all disavowing clan life for as long as they lived.

But not Bhaumiula.

Aftermath and Meeting Alorosis (2912-2978)

Bhaumiula was determined to regain clan status in any way possible, hoping to reform his clan one more. He stayed with his uncle Logieo until his mandatory service, training his element and thinking of how to reach his goal. He stayed in touch with as many

family members as he could, although he knew most of them did not want anything to do with clans anymore. He didn't expect them too, besides Lohenus, who was the former clan heir, after all. He nagged at Lohenus to join him on his quest and stop moping around, going from job to job with no purpose. Lohenus refused and Bhaumiula decided to drop it once his service started, thinking his brother needed to jumpstart himself first before anything happened.

The army provided him the stability and actual steps to help him achieve what he wanted. It gave him a goal to focus on, as he knew if he, and his other family members, achieved greatness here like all those years before, they could regain their old legacy. He started to train himself into being a perfect soldier, taking on the persona of a no nonsense, vulgar mouthed dragon who could get the job done, inspired by an older Lieutenant in his regiment who held the same attitude. His ambassador teachings were soon forgotten. However, this made him disliked by his fellow soldiers, who didn't take kindly to his commanding behavior. He grew isolated from them, which he didn't mind, but it made him socially inept as the years passed.

In the year 2924, he first met his future Unified, Alorosis at a bakery. She seemed unfazed by his personality, coming up with new ways to meet him and get to know him. Over time, she'd be the only dragon that he'd fully listen to outside of his Commanders, something she used to have him do more kind actions when not on deployment. It is because of her that he has a kinder side to him, as rare as it seen.

The following years were unremarkable. He continued training himself, getting better and better by his standards, seeing his goal getting closer and closer. His old fellow soldiers moved on, died, or transferred out, while he stayed as he was. In 2958, he decided to marry Alorosis, wanting her to be by his side and to be her rock until death did them away.

Finally, after many years had passed, he decided it was time to check in on Lohenus and get him in on his plan to become a clan again.

Estrangement with Lohenus (2978-2984)

His first meeting with his older brother, after years of having no contact, was nothing short of disappointing. Learning that Lohenus had done nothing with his life that amounted to anything, he began his old nagging ways, constantly dropping by Lohenus' residence to harass him into becoming something more, something that a clan heir, former or not, was meant to be. Lohenus didn't appreciate this, as he wanted to be left alone and live his life. Despite constantly being told that he didn't want the same things as Bhaumiula, it continued for a long time. Each visit slowly turned more and more hostile, more verbally violent, as Bhaumiula pushed his views and wants onto his brother, who had no use for them.

The breaking point was when, after a battle ended terribly, Bhaumiula once again started to dig into Lohenus, saying being a healer in the army wasn't good enough, he needed to aim higher, do more for his reputation. Tired of the harassment, Lohenus snapped back, saying things he could never take back. Unfortunately, due to a combination of the previous battle, exhaustion, and his own rising anger towards Lohenus, Bhaumiula attacked his brother. The two fought like animals, with Bhaumiula nearly killing his weaker sibling until their uncle Logeio broke them apart. The two went into a period of no contact, refusing to mend the broken bridge between them. As of now, it has not been fixed.

Current Life (2984-3016)

Bhaumiula went on to become a regiment Lieutenant in 2985, where he trains soldiers today to always perform at their best, wanting them to experience the pride he feels when he does so. He and Alorosis had their first son relatively late, compared to other dragons, in 2998, and their child in 3001. Currently, life has been the same and he considers it a good life, despite the clear stain with his relationship with Lohenus. But he doesn't think there's much to fix that.

Roblens

He loves his son more than anything. Seeing him as a successor to his legacy, Roblens is his pride and joy. He encourages Roblens to be the best he can possibly be, constantly telling him about his former clan's history and often glorifying it beyond reason. He hopes that his son can bring the family back in the clan ranks, or at least be more successful than Bhaumiula ever was.

Logizo

There's a much more strained bond between them, but Bhaumiula still loves his child and is proud of them. He tends to argue more with them and they show no interest in

clan life, but he feels like this is more of a side effect of their closer bond with their uncle. Regardless, he'll support Logizo in whatever they do.
