Responsible on a per-event-basis for load-in, setup/installation, testing, manage A/V during Opening
and Closing Ceremonies, provide onsite basic operational training to day-of event volunteer, provide
on-call support during event day, and then responsible for tear down and load-out of A/V equipment.

Location: varies per event. Equipment is stored at The Play Space, in North San Jose.

**Type: Fixed Contract:** Generally we have 4 to 6 major events (regional or district championships) each season where we require a dedicated A/V specialist to get the A/V setup and operational. Generally we expect this to be a total of ~20 hours per event.

Contract Rate: fixed \$500 per event

- Mature and demonstrated ability to get things done with little supervision
- Able to lift up to 40 lbs
- Ability to interact well with diverse groups of people including volunteers that do not have a background in A/V
- Must have reliable transportation and valid up to date car insurance
- If 18 years old or older, must be able to pass *FIRST* background and LiveScan screening; must be at least 16 years old
- Must be U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident Alien. Must have the legal right to work in the US without sponsorship or restrictions
- Strongly Preferred: Experience with FIRST

We expect about 2 to 4 hours for load-in and setup (day before actual event) plus up to 14 hours of the event day and then about 1 to 2 hours for tear down / load-out (same day as event). We anticipate during the event day that the A/V Specialist is on site and available but has given operational training to an event volunteer for the majority of the day and just needs to check in regularly.

Must be able to spend about 4 hours ahead of the event at our building (The Play Space) in San Jose learning the equipment including how to setup, operate, debug and tear down.
