

Digital Toolkit for #SubwayMustAct

UPDATED: May 27, 2020

In light of news reports showing disturbing photos of heavily armed protesters patronizing a Subway restaurant in Raleigh, North Carolina carrying an AT4 rocket launcher, multiple pistols, and shotguns, **we are calling on Subway to keep its employees and customers safe from the threat of gun violence by prohibiting people from openly carrying weapons in its restaurants.**

Research has consistently found that the presence of a visible firearm makes people more aggressive, transforming mere disagreements into violent, and potentially deadly, confrontations. Unfortunately, Subway is no stranger to gun violence. **According to analysis of data from the Gun Violence Archive, Subway has experienced at least 65 incidents of gun violence in or near its restaurants nationwide since 2014, resulting in 21 deaths and 28 injuries.**

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

1. Send an [email](#) or [tweet](#) to Subway. Let them know that customers and employees want to feel safe and welcome at restaurants – without the threat of openly carried firearms.
