General Warm-up Questions

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Recommendation Questions

4. What is your favorite restaurant in Chicago? Why?
 5. Can you recommend a good place for [insert theme: pizza / international food / desserts / a date / family time]?
 6. Is there an activity or attraction in Chicago that you think everyone should try?
 7. Have you ever found a hidden gem or secret spot in the city?
 8. What's a service (like a hair salon, mechanic, or dentist) you've had a great experience with?
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Warning Questions

9. Have you ever had a bad experience at a restaurant or service place? What happened?
10. Is there any place or activity in Chicago that you wouldn't recommend to others? Why not?
11. What's something tourists or new residents should be careful about?

12. Are there any places that look good online but were disappointing in real life?

Follow-up/Detail Questions

13. How did you find out about this place?

14. What did you order/do there?

15. How was the customer service?

16. How much did it cost? Was it worth it?

17. Would you go back again or tell a friend to go?
