Storage Crops to Plant Next Spring

Inchelium Red garlic from local nurseries- softneck, keeps 8-10 months

[Cascade Ruby Gold](#) cornmeal corn

Early Warwick bush dry bean (start in May)

To Make Protective Tunnels to Protect Veg in Winter- great for all year, actually

To Overwinter Tiny Starts for Early Spring Food- Experiment with these

[Walla Walla onions](#) dry down in mid-late June

[Merida carrots](#) Tricky; experiment with planting in October to overwinter as tiny starts that bear in spring
