## **Using MyFreeTaxes for Tax Prep**

#### To qualify for the free software:


- → You can only file for the current tax year (2025). If you need to file for a different year, please go to GetYourRefund.org to get additional assistance.
- → Your household's AGI must be under \$84,000.
- → You must start your return at <a href="MyFreeTaxes.com">MyFreeTaxes.com</a>

#### Gather the following:

- → A valid email address
- → All 2025 tax documents (W2s, 1099s, SSA-1099)
- → Last year's exact Adjusted Gross Income (AGI)
  - ◆ If you didn't file last year, you don't need to enter any information
  - ◆ If you filed at Just Harvest or another Free Tax Prep Coalition tax site in 2024, email taxhelp@justharvest.org and we can provide your AGI.
  - ♦ If you filed a full tax return last year, you can find this information on a copy of your 2024 return or retrieve the information in your IRS account.

#### Tips & best practices


- → Take your time and double check everything before moving on to the next page.
- → Type your name and the name of anyone else on your return exactly as it appears on the social security card or ITIN letter.
- → When entering information from a tax form, make sure it matches exactly what is on the form. Skip any boxes that are blank.

- → If you need help to go back to a previous section or skip ahead to a new section, you can do so by using the left navigation panel. To get to the left navigation panel, click on the option in the top left corner, as highlighted in the image to the right.










# **Adding a Dependent**

If this section does not apply to you, skip ahead to <u>Entering Your Income</u>. Not sure if you can claim someone on your tax return? <u>Read about who qualifies as a dependent.</u>

# **Entering Your Income**

### Common Types of Income

W-2: Wages, salaries, and tips

**1099-G box 1**: Unemployment compensation **1099-INT, DIV, OID**: Interest and dividends

1099-R, RRB, SSA: Retirement and Social Security income (reported on SSA-1099)
1099-NEC: Non-employee compensation; this form automatically creates a Schedule C
1099-K: Payments for contract or self-employment work; this form automatically creates a Schedule C


**Profit or Loss from Business**: Records for self-employment, 1099-NEC, and 1099-K will funnel to this section to create Schedule C. Learn more about Self Employment income <a href="here">here</a>. **Capital Gains and Losses**: 1099-B, 1099-S (from the sale of real estate)

Enter each form exactly as it appears.

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## **Claiming Credits & Deductions**

If you are eligible, the <u>Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit are automatically claimed on your tax return</u>. You typically do not need to enter additional information to claim these credits. Not claiming any other credits? <u>Skip ahead to the next section</u>.



### Adjustments to Income

**Educator Expenses**: Unreimbursed K-12 expenses paid by teachers and school staff **Student Loan Interest Deduction**: Interest paid and reported on Form 1098-E **Health Savings Account Form 8889**: Contributions or distributions reported on Forms 5498-SA and 1099-SA

IRA Deduction: Contributions to a traditional IRA from Form 5498 or IRA records

#### Credits

**Education Credits Form 1098-T:** Qualified education expenses for the taxpayer, spouse, or dependent. Check your school account for Form 1098-T and your account statement. Do not include expenses covered by scholarships or grants. Learn more about education credits <a href="here">here</a>. **Child Care Credit Form 2441**: Expenses for child and dependent care while you work. Note, you must provide the care provider's Employer Identification Number (EIN) or SSN to claim the credit.

**Residential Energy Credit Form 5695**: Expenses for energy improvements for a main home like windows, insulation, and doors.

#### <u>Itemized Deductions</u>

<u>Itemized expenses must be more than your standard deduction for them to help your tax return</u>. The typical standard deduction for single filers is \$15,750 and for married filing jointly is \$31,500. You're encouraged to skip this section if your itemized deductions are significantly less than this amount.

**Mortgage Interest and Expenses**: Mortgage interest, real estate taxes, points paid, and mortgage insurance premiums are normally reported on Form 1098

**Medical and dental expenses:** expenses above 7.5% of your income are deductible **Taxes You Paid**: State and local income taxes plus property taxes paid in 2025 **Gifts to Charity**: Cash and noncash donations. Noncash donations are limited to less than \$500. Additional forms and information are required for noncash contributions over \$500.

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### Other Taxes, Payments & Miscellaneous Forms

No other forms or payments to enter on your tax return? Skip ahead to the next section.

## Payments and Estimates

**Federal Estimated Tax Payments**: Federal tax payments made in 2025 and by January 17, 2025. These payments do not include what is already reported on income tax forms.


**State Estimated Tax Payments**: State tax payments already made for 2025. These payments do not include what is already reported on income tax forms.

### Miscellaneous Forms

**Injured Spouse Allocation**: Form 8379 for Married Filing Joint filers when one spouse has debt that allows the IRS to reduce the amount of their refund.

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

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
# 2 steps may increase your PA refund: Tax Forgiveness and Unreimbursed Employee Expenses

The tax forms that you entered will automatically be carried to your Pennsylvania return. However, additional information may be required to claim certain tax credits or deductions. If you were a part-year resident or non-resident in any other state, you will need to add another state tax return. Visit the <a href="Pennsylvania Department of Revenue website">Pennsylvania Department of Revenue website</a> for detailed instructions on filing your Pennsylvania tax return.






Enter the "Credits" menu and select "Edit" for Schedule SP, Tax Forgiveness Credit.



Select "Yes" to complete the Tax Forgiveness Credit, then scroll down and click "Continue." You typically do not need to enter additional information or income on this page.

If your filing status is Married Filing Separately, you are filing for a deceased taxpayer, or you are a dependent on someone else's tax return, read through the additional questions carefully and select the answers that apply to you.



If you have a record of 2025 unreimbursed work expenses, you may be able to deduct them from your PA taxable income. Common expenses include union dues and fees, uniforms, and work supplies. Go here to learn more about eligible expenses.


To enter these expenses, begin on the main menu for Pennsylvania and click on "Adjustments to Income." Then select "Pennsylvania Schedule UE."

Scroll to the bottom of the screen and select "Schedule UE Entry," and "Add Schedule UE."

You can then select the job with expenses and enter the amounts. Return to the main menu for Pennsylvania when you have entered all of your expenses..





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
# **Finishing Your Return**





Confirm that you've entered all basic and tax information.

Select "Continue" to choose how you would like to receive your refund or pay the taxes owed.



The e-file menu will keep track of which section you are in.



If you're eligible for a federal and/or state refund, you'll be given the option of direct deposit or receiving a check in the mail.

**Note:** The IRS is no longer issuing paper checks unless you qualify for an exception. Visit their website to learn more.




If you owe federal and/or state taxes, you'll be given the option to pay by direct debit (taken directly from an account) or mail payment.

If you choose to mail the payment, you have the following options:

Federal payments: Pay online at <a href="IRS.gov/Payments">IRS.gov/Payments</a>, or mail a check or money order with a payment voucher to the IRS. Find your federal mailing address <a href="here">here</a>.

**Pennsylvania payments:** Pay online at myPath.pa.gov, or mail a check or money order with a payment voucher to the PA Department of Revenue. Find your PA mailing address here.







- 1. If you have your return available, you'll be asked to enter your exact AGI from line 11 of your 1040 (do not round or guess).
- If you filed but can't access your 2024 tax return, you'll have to mail your tax return to the IRS. This will add months to the expected time of receiving your refund.
- 3. If you didn't file last year, you'll be allowed to file without it.



Enter a self-selected PIN. This counts as your electronic signature. You can use this PIN to verify your identity next year.



If you need to make any changes to your information, use the "Edit" options on the e-file menu, or use the main menu on the left side of the screen to go back to your return.

When selecting to sign and file your return, you are officially submitting your return. Make sure you feel comfortable with all the information provided because you will NOT be able to edit the information after this step.



## **After Filing Your Tax Return**

After submitting your tax return, you should expect to see 2-3 notifications from TaxSlayer.

- 1. The first will notify you that your return has been submitted (sent within minutes of submitting your return).
- 2. The second will notify you if your federal return was accepted or rejected by the IRS (typically sent within a few hours of submitting your return).
- 3. If your federal return was accepted and you filed a state tax return, a third message will notify you if your state return was accepted or rejected (typically within a day of when your federal return is accepted).

## Accepted return tips:

- → Save a digital copy of your tax return or print the completed return for your records.
- → If unable to print or save your return, make sure to record your Filing Status, Adjusted Gross Income (line 11 on Form 1040), Federal Refund (if applicable), and State Refund (if applicable). You'll need your exact Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) when you file next year. The other information is helpful when checking on the status of your refund.

- → If you are due a refund, you can check your federal refund status 24 hours after e-filing at: irs.gov/refunds.
- → You can check the status of your PA refund at <u>revenue.pa.gov</u>.
- → If you owe taxes, make sure to pay as much as you can before the filing deadline (April 15, 2026). Interest and penalties may be applied to your balance after the deadline. Find payment information and resources at <a href="irs.gov/payments">irs.gov/payments</a>.

#### If your return was rejected, you should:

- 1. Log in to your account.
- 2. Select the My Account option on the left-hand menu.
- 3. Click the "How to Fix?" link to open a screen that will give you the option to view the explanation of the reject code(s).
