Sept 25, 2021 4:00 - 5:00 pm	<b>Speech: Impromptu</b>  Event description: Impromptu is a speaking event where students have 7 minutes to select a topic, brainstorm ideas, outline and deliver their speech.
Oct 15, 2021 6:00 - 7:00 pm	<b>Impromptu Practice Event</b>  Event description: In a friendly environment, students will have the opportunity to review and use the knowledge they have learned from the Introduction to Impromptu event and practice creating and delivering a speech on the fly! Students will receive feedback and listen to sample responses.
Nov 5, 2021 6:00 - 7:00 pm	<b>Speech: Original Oratory</b>  Event description: Original oratory is a speaking event where students will research extensively on any topic that they are interested in with the intent of informing and persuading the audience of that topic's significance. By learning and utilizing key rhetorical and speaking strategies, they deliver a memorized 10 minute speech and are judged on their effectiveness of development and presentation.
Nov 26, 2021 6:00 - 7:00 pm	<b>Original Oratory Practice Event</b>  Event description: In a friendly environment, students will have the opportunity to review and use the knowledge they have learned from the Introduction to Oratory event. They will then practice writing and delivering a speech. Students will receive feedback and listen to speeches from competitors.
Dec 18, 2022 2:00 - 3:00 pm	<b>DECA Seminar</b>  Event description: DECA, a nonprofit student organization commonly found in middle and high schools, prepares students for careers in marketing, finance, hospitality, and management. In this seminar, students will learn about the various competitive events, with a focus on hospitality events.
Feb 11, 2022 6:00 - 7:00 pm	<b>Tournament Preparation</b>  Event description: In a supportive environment, we will guide students to review the speech topics they learned in the previous events. We will have a tournament, which will take place at the end of February. Students will prepare their speeches in this session.

Feb, 2022	<p><b>Speech/Debate: Congress</b></p> <p>Event description: Congressional Debate is a simulation of the real United States legislature. A group of 10 - 25 students will compete in a legislative round where they debate a series of bills and resolutions. Students will give a 3 minute speech on the side they choose and face a 2 minute cross examination (time for the student to answer questions about their speech) from their fellow competitors.</p>
