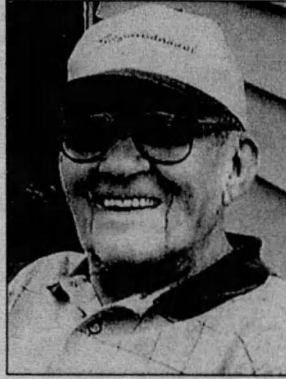


BKR2 Robert F. Waters
