










The South Hero Conservation Commission will be holding an American Kestrel nest box building community event on Saturday, March 8, 2025, in the Folsom gym from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. This project is a partnership with Vermont Institute of Natural Sciences (VINS). According to VINS, "Kestrel populations are declining across North America and one hypothesis is that they lack adequate nesting sites as a result of habitat alteration."
