


Guest WiFi

Connecting to Guest WiFi

For visitors who do not have access to the eduroam wireless network (users without an affiliation to a participating educational institution), a self-service guest registration portal has been made available.

Please ask guests to connect to “UCSB Wireless Web”, then open their browser. Select “Guest Registration” under the credential login. They should be presented with a Guest Registration page that asks for their:

- Full Name
- Mobile Phone Number
- Email Address
