Project Description:	<b>Educate on water rights &amp; improve diversion data reported to the State of CO</b>
Reason for Project:	1) Identify barriers to accurate reporting and explore possible solutions; 2) seek funding to implement possible solutions. Outcomes could include one-on-one education with water right owners to increase understanding of barriers to and benefits of accurate water-rights reporting, including information on shortages; and resources to assist water right owners, support trust-building with DWR staff/water commissioners, investigate use of technology for improved reporting. In close collaboration with DWR and with input from the BRT, identify and address needs related to measuring and reporting water diversions, to support and maintain existing water rights in the Basin. This recommendation is closely associated with other CAA lead Recommendations and could be implemented by Ag Water Coordinators
