#### **Previous Events**

D&G have very kindly agreed to sponsor the Christmas Tree advertising again this year, which is a great opportunity for the PTA to raise up to £2000. We'll be asking for 100 volunteers to 'host' a sign in their gardens in the coming weeks.

Christmas Fete – will run similarly to last years event, it will be a closed event for the children to enjoy all day. Year 1 are going to be organising the inside activities and Year 5 will be taking care of the outside.
