Chaperones:

Report time: 8:00AM

Rehearsal: 8:30-9:45AM

After rehearsal at CHS has ended

Students should take all equipment to the designated loading area (this may change depending on which field we rehearse on). Students must stay and make sure all equipment is loaded unless dismissed by Ms. Larson or other staff present.

Load Trailers: Directions for loading/unloading are listed at the bottom of this document.

After loading trailers:

Students will report back to the band room to begin dressing uniforms.

Begin getting dressed in uniforms: 10:15AM

Once students begin getting dressed, they should make sure to keep their personal items organized at all times, so they do not leave anything behind. Students do not need to wear jackets/gloves/gauntlets on the bus. Hoodies and sweatshirts are permitted only during the bus ride, and until they finish dressing

Buses pick up students and chaperones @ CHS: 10:45AM

All School and District rules apply. **Only students in the CMB, approved chaperones, and certified staff will be allowed on the bus.**

Arrive at Miamisburg High School: 11:30AM

Unload trailers: directions at bottom of document.

Students will wait to eat lunch until after we arrive and unload trailers. Students will have time to eat their lunch from 12:00-12:30PM. Make sure you bring your own lunch!

Warmup begins: 1:00PM

Walk to gate: 1:45PM

Students follow Band Guides to the stadium.

At gate: 1:55PM

Band parents at the stadium will give direction as to how to enter the field and when time begins.

Performance: 2:00PM

Do your best, and have fun!!

Post-Performance-heading back to trailers

Students will help move equipment and instruments back to trailers. Respectful and responsible behavior is expected from every student. If parents/staff observe inappropriate behavior, names will be recorded. After equipment is loaded onto the trailers, jackets/gloves/gauntlets/ may come off and go into their respective uniform bags. The order of loading each trailer is at the bottom of this document.

After loading has finished, students will travel with chaperones to the stadium and are given these options:

- Shop at vendors
- Concessions
- Sit in stands and watch performances. All band members must sit together in the same section.
- Use bathrooms

At no point should students be anywhere other than these locations, unless specifically escorted by a chaperone.

Awards: 4:30PM

Students MUST attend awards ceremonies, they are not optional. Appropriate performance-watching etiquette includes:

- Clapping and cheering in a polite manner/sitting quietly if not applauding
- Picking up any trash before you leave the stands after a performance

Depart Miamisburg: 5:30PM

If Finals: performances start at **7:00PM**- we would be directed as to what our Finals Performance time is.

Finals depart Miamisburg: 10:15PM

Loading trailers: (departure)

- A designated person enters the trailer to hand Winds their cases.
- Flutes and clarinets are responsible for removing garment bags and backpacks, placing them neatly off to the side.

Instrument Loading

- Winds place instruments into their cases and reload them onto the trailer.
- While this happens, percussion removes jackets to prepare for loading.
- Once brass finishes loading their cases, they begin loading their equipment onto the trailer.

Garment Bags & Props

- Once garment bags have been removed, band dads begin loading props onto the trailer.

Jackets & Positioning

- After brass cases are reloaded, Winds may remove jackets.
- Winds then step aside to allow percussion to load equipment and props to be placed. During this time, Winds should refill water bottles for themselves and percussion as needed.

Final Loading

- Once percussion, pit equipment, and props are fully loaded, garment bags are placed back onto the trailer to complete the process.

Unloading Trailers: (arrival)

1. Props & Garment Bags

- Band dads remove props and garment bags from the trailer and lay them out in the designated area.

2. Percussion Unloading

- Percussion members unload their equipment from the trailer.
- While percussion is unloading, Winds should:
 - Put on jackets.
 - Refill any water bottles that need filling (including percussion's).

3. Winds Instrument Cases

- Once percussion is finished, a designated person enters the trailer to hand Winds their instrument cases.

4. Brass & Winds Transition

- Brass players remove their instruments from cases and reload the empty cases onto the trailer.
- Percussion members put on jackets.
- Winds place backpacks and garment bags on the trailer.
