



## **“Stronger Together - 6ft Apart (ST6)” Compliance Team**

This team was originally in charge of executing a deployment plan and compliance strategy for Broomfield’s social distancing, stay at home order.

Due to the state-wide order now in effect, we will stand up this operation on a more limited staffing level. Here is a [graphic representation](#) of our compliance strategy. We redeployed five staff members from parks, rec, and public works starting this morning at 10 a.m. They will be scheduled from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Sunday.

This team of five is assigned to the five wards (one staff member in each ward) and they are educating residents about the requirements of the Stay at Home Public Health Order and encouraging people to remain home for all but essential activities.

Staff uses the marked city and county vehicles, wear a bright orange marked vest, light personal protective equipment, and their CCOB badges. Teams on the schedule meet at PDRC each day at 10 a.m. to pick up all necessary materials, get vehicle assignments and then head out.

We are not asking this team to enforce the order, and they will not be issuing summons. They will have a direct line to both code enforcement and nearby patrol officers to ensure safety and an escalation plan, if needed. Additionally, the police department has each staff member’s assigned cell phone number and approximate locations.

In light of the recently issued public health orders, 9-1-1 dispatchers are receiving a lot of calls from concerned citizens reporting on groups gathering against the social distancing and stay at home requirements. In response, we launched [this graphic and messaging](#) as a proactive measure.

The listed hotline number is staffed by an admin team who are prepared to funnel tips of gatherings to the ST6 team to respond, as well as answer frequently asked questions approved by our public health officials. Notably, 95% of our calls are about the state order parameters which 2-1-1 is more equipped to field.
