# Where can I find my Coach ID?

You can find your Coach ID in your emails from ScholarMatch (advising@scholarmatch.org).

Do I have to complete the training if I am an independent education consultant or have previous professional experience working with first-generation students from low-income backgrounds on college applications?

Once you're invited to complete our training modules, you'll receive an email which includes a link to a training module waiver.

### Can I save my mastery assignment progress and return to it later?

Airtable does not have the capacity to save in-progress work, so we recommend submitting your mastery assignments in one sitting or using a separate document to save your answers if you're unable to complete a module in one sitting.

# When will I be matched?

Matching begins in the spring of every year for all of our existing coaches. For new coaches, the matching process begins in the summer and ends in early fall. To be eligible for matching, coaches must complete all five training modules, one onboarding module, a coach profile, and pass a background check.

# What is a coach profile?

A coach profile helps us select a student match for you and is shared with your student when a match is made. You will upload a photo and share information about yourself and your interests.
