Advanced Placement Course Requirements/Expectations

- Students should not take more than 4 AP classes without Principal/API approval
- Counselors should encourage students to take AP classes based on the data points below and also discourage students to take AP classes based on the data points below

- The counselor will provide the <u>AP contract</u> for students requesting more than 4 AP courses to be completed and returned.
