About Us:

Village Health Works (VHW) is a non-governmental organization that has been operating in Burundi since 2006. The organization addresses issues of social justice in rural areas of Burundi by providing high-quality healthcare, education, and economic development opportunities. VHW operates across five thematic areas (health, education, economic development, food security, and community engagement) to improve local livelihoods and restore dignity and hope to hundreds of thousands of people.

The education program at VHW operates under a memorandum of understanding with the Ministry of Education to support the Kigutu Fundamental School by providing ongoing teacher training, student support services, and encouraging parental involvement in education. VHW's strategic approach in education is also implemented directly through the post-primary Kigutu International Academy (KIA).

About the Position:

The Global Perspective and Leadership Instructor will cultivate students' awareness of international affairs, foster cross-cultural understanding, promote civic responsibility, and develop ethical leadership. The role involves interdisciplinary teaching and mentorship that prepares students to engage thoughtfully and responsibly in a complex, interconnected world.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Curriculum Design and Instruction – 40%

- **Design and deliver** a rigorous, inquiry-based curriculum in:
 - Global issues
 - Governance
 - Sustainability
 - Ethical leadership
- Ensure content is engaging, relevant, and aligned with institutional objectives.

2. Student Engagement and Project Facilitation – 25%

- **Facilitate student-led projects and discussions on:**
 - Current events
 - Human rights
 - Global development
 - Diplomacy
- Guide students in independent inquiry and critical reflection.



3. Experiential and Applied Learning – 15%

- **Integrate experiential learning** such as:
 - Debates
 - Model United Nations
 - Service-learning projects
 - International case studies
- Provide real-world contexts to enhance conceptual understanding.

4. Student Assessment and Feedback – 10%

- **Assess student learning** using a variety of tools.
- Provide **timely and constructive feedback** aligned with institutional and academic standards.

5. Cross-Disciplinary Collaboration – 10%

- **Collaborate with colleagues** to:
 - Promote cross-disciplinary learning experiences
 - Support school-wide leadership development initiatives
 - Contribute to interdisciplinary curriculum planning
