CHALLENGE

Recall the idea that you brainstormed during the ice breaker (or choose from the ideas provided)
You will develop a business plan and prepare for an elevator pitch
An elevator pitch is a quick explanation of your idea and why someone should be interested in it
It should be short enough for someone to hear while meeting you in an elevator
Imagine that you run into a famous investor in an elevator and you only have one minute to tell them about your amazing idea and why they should support you! Assume you already have built a prototype

Students then brainstorm their ideas using the guiding questions on the brainstorm slide, following the guidelines on the how to present your pitch slides
