## **Outline of Activities:**

- Story time behavior expectations (1 minute)

  - We ask that you keep your child within arm's reach at all times to avoid accidents.

- Puppet time (Ramadan drummer)
  - O What is Ramadan About?
    - A Muslim holiday during which Muslims fast from dawn to sunset
    - They eat a pre-dawn meal called suhoor and will not eat anything else until the end of the day. When the sun sets, they will eat Iftar. They will do this for 30 days
    - After Ramadan comes a BIG celebration called Eid-Ul-Fitr

- Ramadan is a month of giving, practicing patience, doing a lot of reflection, reading the Quran (the Muslim Holy Book) and practicing gratitude.
- Ask Children:
  - What are some of your favorite things to do during Ramadan?
  - What are some acts of kindness we can do during Ramadan?
