This example is to help understand what a Fix It Ticket could look like if one comes home. This example does not have to be signed.

Fix It Ticket Example

Today I was asked to fill out a Fix It Ticket because I made a decision that interrupted learning in our classroom. Respect is an important part of our classroom community, so I took a moment to reflect on how I will refocus on respect.

Describe why you are filling out this Fix It Ticket:

I am filling out a Fix It Ticket because I left to go to the restroom during a lesson and I was fooling around in the halls. When I came back into the classroom, I was being silly and interrupted my classmates. I decided to spend my learning time playing and talking instead of focusing on growing and learning.

Tomorrow I will have a fresh start. Here are three things I will do to stay focused on respectful behavior:

- 1. I will try to use the restroom during homeroom, between classes, or during recess/lunch.
- 2. I will walk back to class immediately and quietly if I need to use the restroom during class.
- **3.** I will focus on learning when I am at school and will allow my classmates to do the same.
