

Read&Write for Google Chrome - Superheroes Facilitator Guide

Facilitator Notes: To help support your school using Read&Write for Google Chrome with students, we've put together this training to enable in-school training.

This lesson is designed to teach students the main functions that are available in Read&Write for Google Chrome. The main objective is to make students excited to use Read&Write.

It is suitable for all students and takes approximately 2 hours to complete.

Student Outcomes:	Students will understand how to: • access the Read&Write for Google Chrome toolbar • have text read aloud using Text-to-Speech • use the Dictionary to understand what a word means • use the Picture Dictionary to see an image for a word • change the colour of the screen to make it easier to read • create a Vocabulary List • use the Highlights to identify key information and collect this to make it easier to refer to again • use Prediction to help create written work • use Check It to proof written work • create an audio book from written work using Audio Maker
Preparation Required:	Direct students to log into Chrome and open Read&Write
Introduction (optional):	Introduce the idea of Superheroes
Lesson Activity:	Video guided demonstration and instruction with guided practice
Discussion:	What are your thoughts on using Read&Write?
Extension (optional):	Show the Settings
Follow Up:	Show students how to access the PDF Reader , Screenshot Reader , and Voice Note
