Emerging Educators Academy - Saturday, January 22, 2022, Drake University

- SOE collaborated with the IA DE and the ISEA to offer the annual Emerging Educator's Academy, "Filling in the Gaps."
- 150 educators attended Topics covered creating a community of learners (at the elementary and secondary levels), knowing students (SEL for kids and responsive teaching), and learning from others (ways to make learning stick, and the power of labels). There was also a student panel and a teacher panel, and a special address from the 2021 National Teacher of the Year, Juliana Urtubey.

STEM Scholarships Available: Jeff Weld-Governor's STEM Advisory Council created two 'new' scholarships for STEM professionals to enter teaching – 1) for STEM professionals seeking support to career-transition to teaching (via RAPIL - Regents Alternative Pathway to Iowa Licensure), and 2) for in-service STEM teachers seeking support to enroll in a course to update skills and knowledge (10 scholarships per semester). Please share this information with individuals who you think might be interested in applying - applications opened January 1, 2022.

Two bills of interest related to teacher recruitment legislation (shared by ISEA):

HSB 519 – Expansion of Teach Iowa Scholar Program – Expands the existing Teach Iowa scholar program. to any content area or grade to address shortages. Expands eligibility from the top 25% of candidates to the top 50%. Ensure equitable distribution among teachers who serve in school districts above and below 1,200 students was also included. This bill passed unanimously out of committee. Additional appropriations are key to ensure this program aids in recruitment and retention of early educators. But this is a pivotal first step in expanding the program and attracting more teachers to lowa classrooms.

HSB 520 – Elimination of Teacher Preparation Standardized Assessments - This bill eliminates a 2013 requirement for teacher preparation programs, including those at our lowa Regent institutions, to implement standardized assessments like the Praxis or edTPA. Evidence shows these assessments can be a barrier for some who would otherwise qualify to become lowa licensed teachers (initial license), including a disproportionally large number of students of underrepresented populations.

- Update on Curriculum Leads Academy Plans for 2022 (Kevin Vidergar)
 - Planning Team-meeting monthly via Zoom. On track in completing actions
 - Formed-marketing subcommittee-begin advertising the Academy
 - Registration will be \$275 for members and \$320 for nonmembers.
 - Presenters-receive registration, mileage, and one night hotel stay-must submit receipts
 - Articles in The Source focused on one of the eight functions of highly effective curriculum leads and asking for input from readers.
 - Developing a list of potential topics and presenters for the Academy.
 - Looking ahead to the February meeting, the team will...

 - o contacting confirmed presenters to verify that the day and time will work
 - o contacting potential presenters to invite/encourage them to present and share the day/time
