Reunion 2026 Frequently Asked Questions

The Office of Advancement uses the most recent information that alumni have provided on file. To ensure you stay up-to-date with events and news at the College, please <u>update your information</u>.

REGISTRATION

How should I register guests?

After completing your <u>registration</u>, you will be prompted to "Add a guest." Select this option, input your guest's information and complete their registration.

Can I bring my children? How do I register them?

If you plan to bring your kiddos, we kindly ask that you connect with the alumni engagement team at alumni@eckerd.edu before completing their registration. Please note that some events may not be suitable for younger guests. For paid events, standard registration fees apply for all guests.

When does the Early Bird discounted registration rate expire?

Early Bird discounted rates are available if registration is completed prior to January 19. Event prices increase on January 19.

May I get a refund for my registration if I can no longer attend?

Full refunds are available if the request is made prior to January 19. Refunds of 50% are available between January 20–February 13. No refunds will be issued after February 13.

Are there rooms available to rent on campus during Reunion?

Rooms are not available to rent on campus during Reunion Weekend. However, Eckerd has partnered with local hotels to offer discounted rates through late January. A list of hotels can be found here.

EVENTS

How do I access campus during Reunion?

For easy entry at the campus gate, please print this Reunion Parking Pass and leave it on your dashboard.

How do I receive my drink ticket at Fridays with Faculty and Friends and the Decade Gathering?

Each individual must <u>register</u> prior to the event to receive a drink ticket. Walk-up registration is available.

How do I check out watercraft (e.g. kayaks, paddle boards, sailboats) from the Waterfront?

In order to rent watercraft from the <u>Waterfront</u>, you must have a photo ID, pass the swim test*, and sign a <u>visitor waiver</u>.

*You only need to pass the swim test once. If your student swim test is still on file, you will not need to retake the test.
