### Dear Students and Parents:

As our year gets underway, I would like to invite 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students to consider becoming a part of the school choir, *The Wildcat Chorale*. This is a great opportunity for students who love music to experience it differently. There are no prerequisites for joining the group. You don't have to be a great singer, either. Just sing and have fun!

The choir will be meeting for the first time on **Tuesday, Sept. 10, from 2:40-3:45.** We will practice each Tuesday at the same time. Choir will be a lot of fun, but come prepared to work hard! Please bring the following signed contract and a pencil to rehearsal.

## **Expectations**

- Please be on time to rehearsal, as we do not have a lot of time.
- Behavior needs to be controlled by the student. You are joining a prestigious group and are expected to demonstrate self control and respect. Students not able to do this will be asked to leave the group. This is NOT like regular music class where you will get multiple warnings.
- Students will need to arrive on time and will meet in the music room after school.
- Always arrive with music, a pencil, and a great attitude. We will be learning music from all over the world: some of it familiar and some very new styles. We will also be singing 2 and 3-part music. This can be a challenge, but is very much worth it when we create beautiful sounds.
- Choir is a team 'sport'. As such, it is absolutely necessary that we rehearse together as often as possible. Because we meet only once per week and have several different performances, students are permitted only 2 absences (for any reason) from rehearsals per semester/concert. If a student misses 3 or more he/she will be required to do a singing preparedness test for me before they are able to perform at the next concert. If a student has excessive absences from rehearsals they may be removed from the group. A singer's lack of responsibility in remembering to sign in (how attendance is taken) is not an excuse and will be counted as an absence.
- Singers are expected to practice and memorize their music at home. Practice tracks are provided to students in their Google Classroom.
- Our **season is from 9/10-12/19**. Students are expected to commit to the choir for the entire season. We rely on every student's voice and it negatively affects the group when people drop out in the middle of the season. Please don't do that to your team!
- Students who are new to *The Wildcat Chorale* or who need a new **choir T-shirt** will need to buy a shirt. The cost is **\$10**. The T-shirt design will remain the same each year so T-shirts can be used from year to year. This is a one time cost, as long as the student T-shirt is in good condition and still fits. Because this is an extra-curricular group there are no scholarships available. This is a part of the uniform and it is expected that all singers have a T-shirt. Students will also be asked to have a pair of blue jeans or dark pants (not leggings please; we will be tucking our shirts in) and tennis shoes to wear for concerts.
- Additionally, there is a cost of \$15.00/singer to help cover the cost of purchasing music and supplies (for a total of \$25 for T-shirt and music).
