Calais Middle/High School (CMHS) serves students from Calais, Robbinston, and many surrounding communities. Located in Washington County on the Canadian border, the region's economy is supported by education, pulp and paper, and seasonal industries such as fishing, blueberry harvesting, and wreath-making.

CMHS houses multiple learning pathways, including the Calais Alternative School, The Cobscook Institute, and the St. Croix Regional Technical Center (CTE), which offers programs in Culinary Arts, Business, Early Childhood Education, Computer Electronics, CNA, Automotive Technology, Building Trades, Welding, Truck Driving, Criminal Justice, and a 9th Grade Exploratory Program.
