Guiding Symbol: Comb



A comb has an ancient history as a feminine tool and talisman. Hair combs have been found in the gravesites of multiple cultures since the stone age, buried with the dead. Their finger-like structure represents the rays of the sun, shining a light through the dark of the underworld. They were believed to appease the vulture of death and were worn on a woman's body for protection and adornment.

The indo-european word for comb is *ghombos* meaning tooth and the greek word is *kteis*, meaning the plectrum of a lyre or a weaver's comb. The weaver's comb connects the comb's power to creativity and joining the opposing forces of warp and weft. A rooster comb welcomes the light back from the dark of night and is associated with Mercury, who was able to navigate through the underworld. A rake or plow is another form of comb, opening the dark earth.

The comb invites sun consciousness of light, creativity and plant growth. They are also associated with the magic and feminine power of sea goddesses and hair in mythology. Hair holds archetypal qualities of beauty and power. Hair can also show 'the state of one's head'. A comb can disentangle, unknot, smooth and caress our souls through rhythm and attention. It represents a strong feminine, harmonious Yin energy.

Sun in Sagittarius (outer identity) Your sun sign is a roaming fire, philosophical, intellectual and full of faith. There is a sense that you are going big in this lifetime. The centaur aiming its arrow at life's deepest questions. As a centaur, you are by nature half domesticated and half wild.
