**Abstract:**

We have partnered with community based organizations like Center for Domestic Peace, The Ritter Center, Play Marin and Marin Health and Human Services. We use both quantitative and qualitative methods to better understand health and well-being in human subjects. Students in this lab will learn to conduct a research study from beginning to end - developing a research question of interest, composing an IRB application, using different study design methods, collecting data from surveys or interviews, analyzing data using analytic programs such as SPSS or Dedoose, and composing a publishable manuscript. Research topics change from year to year, but the strength of our methodologies remain the same.
