Uniform Policy

Edenthorpe Hall Primary Academy is a school proud to wear its uniform. All pupils attending the school will be required to wear the uniform at all times. There will be no exceptions; there will be no excuses. We encourage pupils to take pride in their own appearance.

UNIFORM

Our school uniform from September 2025 will comprise:

- Navy blue sweatshirt / Navy blue cardigan logo or no logo
- White polo shirt or white shirt/ blouse
- Grey trousers/ skirt/pinafore dress
- Grey/ black or white socks or tights
- Black shoes (no trainers and no heels)

To encourage a sense of community and belonging we actively encourage uniform to be worn which displays the school logo.

Non-uniform days

There will be occasional non-uniform days throughout the year where a nominal charge will be made for coming in different clothing. This will usually be in aid of a nominated charity and there will usually be a theme. Where a theme is stipulated children must only come in clothing around that theme and that is appropriate for wearing in school. Otherwise uniform should be worn as normal on these days. Please ensure that all non-uniform is appropriate and does not include cropped tops and very short dance style shorts.

JEWELLERY

No jewellery except for watches and plain studs. If you have piercings, only one set of earrings will be allowed. No other piercing will be allowed.

MAKE-UP

No make-up or nail polish is allowed. Children coming to school wearing make up will be asked to remove it and parents will be contacted.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. All equipment brought to school should be clearly marked.
- 2. Watches and ear studs should be removed for PE lessons.
- 3. A strong bag is necessary for carrying books and sports equipment.
- 4. A sensible outside coat can be worn when necessary.

Pupils will not be allowed to wear any outdoor clothing within the school building. They will be asked to remove coats, jackets, hoodies, etc, and place them in a school bag prior to entry to the school building.

PE UNIFORM

Pupils are expected to bring kit to change into for PE. It is not appropriate for pupils to wear the kit they wear for PE during other lessons.

- White T shirt (school logo or non-logo)
- Black shorts
- Black or grey tracksuit if possible. Dark coloured if not.
- Black pumps/ dark coloured trainers

Pupils who need to be excused from lessons for medical reasons should still bring their kit to wear. It is important to continue to develop PE knowledge and skills through less

physical aspects of the work, eg, coaching, planning and evaluating.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU HAVE YOUR NAME IN EACH ITEM OF YOUR SCHOOL CLOTHING, SHOES AND PE KIT, SO IT CAN BE RETURNED IF LOST.

REMEMBER VALUABLE ITEMS SHOULD NOT BE BROUGHT INTO SCHOOL

The remainder of the uniform may be obtained from a wide variety of retail outlets.

Clean uniform will be held by the school; pupils will be expected to change into that uniform if they attend school with the incorrect uniform. This includes PE kit.
