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Purpose - The purpose of this course is to provide grade 4 students math education which focuses on the PA Core Standards for Mathematics. The four standard areas: Numbers and Operations, Algebraic Concepts, Geometry, and Measurement, Data, and Probability

Materials - We will be utilizing a variety of tools during this school year, which include but are not limited to: the series Everyday Math 4, Study Island, Spring Math. The following materials will be provided:

- Notebook - Each new lesson student will put notes and sample problems in their notebook
- Everyday Math Journal 1 & 2 - These are the books that students will complete practice in class. (usually stays in school)
- Home Link - Any practice homework problems will be in this book
- Calculator - kept in class and should not be used on homework

Grading - Grades will be a combination of homework and tests. (see below)

Homework -

5 points- homework turned in on time

3 points- homework turned in late

0 points- not turned in

Additionally papers will be graded for points. Please note: There is a homework helper in each unit parent letter may be referred to. There are a few homework answers given to be sure students are on the right track.
