Family Needs - Shawna Beckner (update from Jillean)

- So far this year:
 - Put together the snack containers for each grade sounds like those were a hit again this year.
 - Only funds for the containers came from the committee budget.
 - All snacks were donated by the parents on the committee.





- Next year we need to include the specials teachers as well.
- o Paid down the overdue lunch bill for one (1) student.
- Gathered donations for a student in need of winter clothes.
 - Committee members donated \$150 no funds from the committee budget were used.
- Shawna asked Mrs. Eslick if she had any needs and she said that at the beginning of the year students always come to her in need of folders with brads.
 - Used the budget to buy 100 folders.
- Shawna met with Mrs. Eslick to brainstorm other ideas.
 - Working with another school was something discussed, but she said that even though there are other schools that have more students in need, those schools have larger PTA budgets so their PTA really isn't in huge need.
 - She does meet with other counselors in the district though and said she would ask and let us know if any needs came up.
- Shawna is suggesting if we have leftover money at the end of the year in the Family Needs budget that we should buy yearbooks like we have in the past, help with 5th grade recognition individual fees if needed, and if there is still money left, split it between the studios and give them Amazon gift cards.

 - We had guite a few parents volunteer and come to cheer on their runners.

- The goal was for each student to raise \$30 = a total of \$8820.
 - We reached that goal and set a goal to smash 2022's amount and to raise \$20,000.
- In 2022 \$19,189.10 was raised; this year we raised \$19,005.43.
 - Difference of \$183.67.
- We had 63% participation from all students
