

Here are the steps along with screenshots. Please note that this has worked on my computer as well as my mom, Harinder's, computer. However, everyone's device may have different settings.


- 1. Open 'Settings' on your computer and search 'keyboard,' then click on 'Edit language and keyboard options.'
- 2. Next, click 'Add a language.'
