Treasury to fund the ongoing maintenance costs of Guide to Polkadot-JS.


1. Context of the proposal:

<u>Guide to Polkadot-JS</u> has been providing step-by-step instructions for **Polkadot-JS** Extension and Apps since early July 2021.

Previous funding from the Polkadot Treasury was provided in <u>September 2022</u> and <u>December 2022</u>. This supported the redesign of the original website to improve the User experience and the User interface for better findability and usability; as well as the publication of content related to the bulk of **Polkadot-JS** functionalities.

- RMRK on Statemine/Karura/Bifrost (this is not ledger compatible): it requires Polkadot.js or Talisman or Subwallet wallet.



Don't confuse the Existential Deposit (needed to keep an account active on-chain) and the Minimum Staking bond (needed to nominate/stake and earn rewards).

The **ED** has never changed on Polkadot: it was always 1 DOT.

The MSB has changed a lot over the past 2 years, but it is currently 10 DOTs. However, you need to bond about 125 DOTs to be able to get staking rewards.




