- The first week included a lot of behavior expectation setting overall. Julia is also busy working with many new students on DCMS behavior expectations as well.
- Enrollment:
 - Target was 545 in order to sustain current teacher FTE
 - Projection was 517 students; currently at 547 students
 - accepted every 6th grader who applied max'd at 200; more strategic enrollment for 7th & 8th graders.
 - Enrollment will shift through Sept; will stay as close to 545 as possible;
 expect current FTE to be okay if we come in close
- Skate City night was great; estimate 75-100 kids in attendance
- A parent asked about other opportunities for kids to socialize
 - o may look into Round One or Urban Air (Main Event wasn't overly successful)
