All-Stars/Mid Caps Championships

After Divisionals, the top 16 swimmers (and top 8 relays) from across A, B & C Divisions will be invited to swim at All Stars (held at Annville-Cleona) on Sunday, July 20.

Mid Caps is the Saturday following All Stars (July 26), and is made up of the top 8 swimmers from MPSL & CASL All Stars meets. This year Mid Caps is hosted by the CASL and will be at Central York.

The league requires that if you swim at All Stars, you must also be available for Mid Caps. Please give us a YES/NO declaration on the events tab. <u>Declare here</u> for your availability. It's all or nothing, as these two events are a combo. <u>Again you must qualify</u>, but we need to know that if you do qualify, you are going to be available to swim at both.

If you are unsure if your swimmer may qualify, a great place to check is the MPSL Top 20 list. After each week, MPSL updates its top 20 swimmers in each event. If your swimmer is on this list, chances are strong that they will make All Stars, and decent that



they will make Mid Caps. Here is a link to the top 20 info that will be updated weekly. MPSL TOP 20. This information is helpful for choosing Divisionals events too.






